An Act to protect the property and rights of Married Women in Upper Canada.

THEREAS the law of Upper Canada relating to the property of Preamble. Married Women is frequently productive of great injustice, and it is highly desirable that amendments should be made therein for the better protection of their rights; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

Nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to prevent any ante-nuptial settlement or contract being made in the same manner and with the same effect as such contract or settlement might be made if this Act had not been passed; but notwithstanding any such contract or settle- 25 ment, any separate real or personal property of a married woman, acquired either before or after marriage, and not coming under, or being affected by such contract or settlement, shall be subject to the provisions of this Act, in the same manner as if no such contract or settlement had been made.
