Read for example on Romans v. 12, "And so death passed upon all men," etc., one of the most difficult sentences in the epistle, and views similar to those of Hofman and Dietzsch, which Golet and Meyer so summarily dismiss, are ably, and, I think, correctly defended. The work is a credit to Canadian scholarship and to Canadian Methodism.

QUADRENNIAL REPORT

OF THE
SECRETARY OF EDUCATION.

THE duties assigned to me were defined by the last General Conference in the following resolution:—

“We recommend the General Conference to appoint a Secretary of Education, whose duty it shall be to take charge of and promote the scheme of College Federation, and to further the interests of the Educational Society.”

To the work assigned in the latter clause of the resolution, I shall confine the first part of my report.

At the time of the last General Conference the income of the Educational Society was \$11,954. The progressive interest in the great work of Christian higher education has been steadily maintained and increased during the Quadrennium, as will appear from the following comparative statement:—

The slight increase of last year over the former years of the Quadrennium may be accounted for by the condition of the

roads during the past winter, and the widespread prevalence of "la grippe."

The importance of this work to the future of our Church, and also of our country, can hardly be over-estimated. By this means scores of young men, called of God to the work of the ministry, are annually furnished with the training necessary to their great work. But of equal, if not greater importance, is the fact that hundreds of cultured young men and women go forth every year from these academic halls to become influential members of society, and not a few of them, to become pillars in the Church of God, and leaders in all good works. With increased intelligence and more thoroughly trained minds, these young people, who are the hope of the future, must bring to their work not only better methods, but also broader conceptions of Christian duty, and a more permanent, because a more intelligent, consecration to the service of Christ.

The second department of work assigned to me by the General Conference, was the raising of an endowment and building fund for Victoria University, in order to the effective completion of Federation.

Until the close of the Conference year of 1886-7, the claims of Elm Street Church upon my time precluded any

systematic organization or canvass through the country generally. My attention was, therefore, directed mainly to the City of Toronto, and by the close of the Conference year subscriptions were secured amounting to the sum of \$130,000.

At the Conference of 1887, a systematic plan was adopted to cover the entire field within the Province of Ontario. About \$250,000 were apportioned to the Conferences within these limits, and the apportionments were generally accepted by the Conferences at the sessions of that year.

Very encouraging subscriptions were obtained at several of the Conferences, and hearty sympathy was accorded to the movement by the great majority of the ministers and laymen present. Either at the Conference or at a meeting of the Conference Special Committee shortly after, a distribution of the amount accepted by each Conference among the several districts was made, and arrangements effected for holding district conventions throughout our work.

During the following year, with the assistance of several brethren, lay and clerical, a convention was held in each principal district in the Province of Ontario. In connection with each convention a public meeting was held, and subscriptions secured, thus largely effecting a canvass of the principal centres. The result by the first of May, 1888, was a subscription list of \$195,000.

This form of work was continued at the following Annual Conferences, and up to the month of October of that year. At that date a meeting of the Board of Regents with the Advisory Committee appointed by the last General Conference was called, and it was decided that, if by the first of May, 1889, the sum of \$100,000 cash should be secured, and the subscription list should be advanced to, say, \$250,000, the Board should take into consideration the propriety of proceed-

ing at once with the buildings, and other steps towards Federation.

Pursuant to these resolutions, I addressed myself first to the completion of the canvass in the City of Toronto.

Sermons were preached in all our churches in the city in the month of December, and subscriptions solicited by committees of influential laymen, the result being an increase in the subscription list of over \$20,000.

When the Board and Advisory Committee assembled on the 2nd of May, 1889, the subscription list stood at \$250,613.25, of which \$108,112.62 had been placed in the hands of the Treasurer in cash and accepted bank paper.

At this date an injunction was served upon the Board of Regents restraining them from further proceeding in the matter of Federation, and rendering further progress in the matter of securing subscriptions or cash payments exceedingly difficult.

The subscription list at present stands at nearly \$270,000.

During the past year the University has lost one of its best friends, and the Church one of its most devoted members, in the decease of the late Wm. Gooderham. By the provisions of his will, a further sum of \$200,000 is now available for the Federation fund. The amount named at the last General Conference is thus fully provided for, though the terms of Mr. Gooderham's will require a slight increase of estimate which can easily be covered in the near future should this Conference so order.

In making this report we cannot but express our gratitude to the great Head of the Church, who has sustained us in a work of unprecedented difficulty and perplexity, and has brought us to so satisfactory a point in this great educational movement. We have also to thank our brethren in the

ministry of our Church in the Conferences and many noble laymen for their co-operation and sympathy in this work. Without their help the success realized would have been impossible.


We cannot but refer also to the wonderful spirit of liberality which God hath poured upon the Church in this movement. Thirty subscribers consecrate nearly \$150,000 to this work, in sums varying from \$1,000 to \$30,000. The legacy of the late Mr. Gooderham is the largest ever left to our Church for the work of God, and involves a corresponding responsibility.

And among the nearly 4,000 minor subscribers there are hundreds who have given according to their means with a princely liberality,

It is therefore with strong faith in the future of our Educational work that this report is respectfully presented for your consideration.

REPORT OF INSTITUTIONS.

The Colleges and Schools connected with the Methodist Church in Canada may be classified as follows :—

1. Connexional Institutions.
2. Conference "
3. Proprietary "
4. Missionary "
5. Sabbath Schools.

I. Connexional Institutions.

These are such as are vested in the entire Church, and are under the direct control of the General Conference. They are Victoria University, Cobourg ; Mount Allison University, Sackville, N.B. ; Wesleyan Theological College, Montreal ; Albert College, Belleville ; Alma Ladies' College, St. Thomas ; and Wesley College, Winnipeg. Reports for the past year have been received from these several institutions, as follows :—

VICTORIA UNIVERSITY, Cobourg, was founded as the Upper Canada Academy by Royal Charter, in the year 1835. In 1841 the institution obtained University powers, and changed its name to "Victoria College." In 1850 power was given to remove to Toronto. It has now Faculties in Arts, Theology, Law, Medicine and Physical Science. Previous to 1868 an

annual grant of \$5,000 was made to the University by the Parliament of Canada. This grant then terminating, a movement was initiated by the Rev. Dr. Punshon to secure for the University a suitable endowment from private benefactions. The productive endowment Fund is now \$150,000, with \$30,000 more accruing from legacies payable in the near future. The past year has been one of the most successful in the history of the University. The number of students was 507, as follows, in

The class for Junior Matriculation in 1890 numbered nearly seventy, the largest in the history of the institution.

The staff embraces twelve professors in Arts and Theology. The total number of graduates is, 582 in Arts, 82 in Theology, 113 in Law, 1,579 in Medicine, or 2,372 in all faculties.

MOUNT ALLISON UNIVERSITY began its history with the Male Academy at Sackville, N.B., in 1842, an institution which was the gift to the Church of Charles F. Allison, Esq. He also founded the Female Academy in 1854. In 1862 the institution was incorporated and acquired full University powers, and in 1866 its present name was given by the Legislature, viz., The University of Mount Allison College. In addition to the two Academies mentioned above (the latter

being now known as the Mount Allison Ladies' College), it has University Departments in Arts and Theology. The numbers of students last session were, in

THE WESLEYAN THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE, Montreal, was founded by the Wesleyan Methodist Church in Canada in the year 1873. In 1878 it was, by order of the General Conference of the former Methodist Church of Canada, incorporated and affiliated with McGill University. It is one of four Protestant Theological Colleges in Montreal affiliated with this University, and the second of them in point of attendance and equipment. In 1883 there were finished the commodious buildings which it now occupies. It has acquired from Parliament the power of conferring degrees in Divinity, and exercised this power for the first time at the last Convocation. No degrees in Course are given without attendance at lectures. Its work includes the following Curricula:—

- I. Preliminary Course, as prescribed by the General Conference
- II. Matriculation Course, as prescribed by the University.
- III. Course in Arts, as prescribed by the University.
- IV. French Course, as prescribed by the General Conference.
- V. College Course for Probationers, as prescribed by the General Conference.
- VI. Course for the Degree of S.T.L., as prescribed by the Senate.
- VII. Course for the Degree of B.D., as prescribed by the Senate.

WESLEY COLLEGE, Winnipeg, was founded in 1873, and for a few years continued its educational work, which, however, had at length to be abandoned on account of insufficient equipment. The need of suitable provision for this institution is one of the most pressing wants of Canadian Methodism. The Manitoba Conference, at its recent session, placed itself in hearty co-operation with the Board of Trustees, to establish the College in an active and honorable position. Generous contributions have already been made to form a Sustentation Fund for three years, during which time the Endowment Fund is to be materially increased. The first students from this Institution have just been sent up to the Provincial University for graduation—two—and at the last sessional examinations four scholarships were taken by the students of this College. The prospect is favorable of a large increase in the attendance next year. Number of students the past session, 35, of whom 20 are studying to prepare for the ministry.

THE ALBERT COLLEGE, Belleville, was begun by the former Methodist Episcopal Church of Canada, in 1857, as the Belleville Seminary. In 1866 it acquired the name of Albert College, with limited University powers, and in 1871 it obtained full University powers. In 1885, in consequence of the Methodist Union of 1883, it became incorporated with Victoria University, continuing most efficiently its operations since then as a higher Seminary and affiliated with the

University. The Ladies' Department, known as the Alexandra College, is still most successfully maintained. Total number of students last year, 173.

THE ALMA LADIES' COLLEGE, St. Thomas, Ont., for the higher education of young women under religious auspices, was incorporated by the Legislature of Ontario in the year 1877. It was founded by the Methodist Episcopal Church of Canada, and in 1883, by resolution of the General Conference, it carried into the United Church the connexional character which it formerly sustained. It is one of the best equipped Ladies' Colleges in America. Owing to the very rapid growth of the school, and the pressing demands for more accommodation, the Board of Management has erected a magnificent addition, 40 x 80 feet, five stories in height (known as McLachlin Hall), devoted to class-room and dormitory accommodation. This new building contains a chapel, with seating capacity of 500, and an Art room, said to be unsurpassed in America. It is well lighted with skylight 40 x 8 feet, and thoroughly furnished with apparatus, etc. Number of students last year, 212. Its professors and certificated teachers number 20.

II. Conference Institutions.

STANSTEAD WESLEYAN COLLEGE.—This institution was incorporated by Act of Parliament in 1872. The aim of its original founders was to provide for the youth of both sexes the means of a higher education under Christian influences. In 1876 it was transferred to the Montreal Conference of the Methodist Church. While, however, the Methodist Church has assumed the responsibility of its maintenance and moral government, the leading Protestant Churches are represented upon its Faculty and Board of Trustees. Pupils representing both the Protestant and Catholic Churches have been in

attendance during the past year, the religious preferences of students being always most scrupulously respected by the Faculty of Instruction. The institution is now affiliated with McGill University, Montreal, and so offers greater attractions than ever to students, and will, from this time forward, have increased claims upon the patronage of the public generally. The Course of Study has been made extensive, embracing the Academic, Ladies' Collegiate, Commercial, Matriculation, Undergraduate Course (first two years at McGill), Music, Painting and Drawing, etc. The college surroundings are unsurpassed in the Province for beauty. The building is most admirably adapted for the accommodation of both sexes, and affords ample room for over one hundred boarders, and an equal number of day pupils, and is a most attractive home for young ladies and gentlemen. Staff of teachers last year, 7; number of students enrolled, 110.

THE METHODIST COLLEGE, St. John's, Newfoundland. This institution has had marked success during the past year. Provided with a very fine suite of buildings containing most eligible school-rooms, etc., and with a good supply of apparatus for the laboratory and of other appointments for educational work, it has an efficient staff of instructors, two of whom are university graduates, and four others highly certificated teachers. Besides, in the Primary and Model School, it has two teachers of first grade. The average attendance of pupils per quarter was 220 in the College proper, and 112 in the Primary School. Thirty-one persons were under training as pupil teachers, and eleven received certificates. The Home provides board, etc., for non-resident students from the outports, and has had a most successful year under the management of Rev. George P. Story, Guardian and Chaplain, supplying a need long and urgently felt by the denomination. The Methodist schools of

the colony, numbering 135, are under the superintendence of Rev. George S. Milligan, LL.D., according to whose latest report education is making much progress; the total attendance in these was 7,913, an increase of 496 during the year.

III. Proprietary Institutions.

THE WESLEYAN LADIES' COLLEGE, Hamilton, was the first Ladies' College incorporated in Canada. It was opened in 1861, on a very broad and comprehensive basis. It has over 150 rooms, and is the most commodious college building in the country. Many rival institutions have arisen since its opening, both in our own Church and in connection with other denominations, but it still holds a foremost place. It is affiliated with Victoria University, and has a College Course of four years followed by University examinations. The Music Department has been broadened into a full Conservatory Course, with a very strong faculty. The Art Department is very completely equipped also. The College has nearly 300 graduates, exclusive of Music and Art. Its pupils numbered 145 last session.

THE ONTARIO LADIES' COLLEGE at Whitby is one of the most progressive institutions in this country. A finer location for a college in close proximity to a large city can scarcely be imagined. A large and gifted faculty, elegant and comfortable buildings, a new gymnasium and every modern means of amusement and exercise render it a delightful home for the higher education of young women. Pupils are regularly prepared for teachers' and other examinations. Attendance, 155.

IV. Missionary Institutions.

The Educational agencies of our Missionary Societies constitute one of the most interesting features of their work. The following is a list of the institutions:—The Anglo-

Japanese College at Tokyo; the Chinese Schools at Victoria, Vancouver, and New Westminster, B.C.; 27 Indian Schools, viz., in Ontario, 11; west of Ontario, 13; Quebec, 3; and 4 French Schools. The Woman's Missionary Society is vigorously prosecuting its Educational work in connection with the Ladies' Schools at Tokyo, Shizuoka and Kofu, Japan; the McDougall Orphanage, at Morley; the Crosby Home, at Port Simpson; the Indian Boarding School, at Chilliwack, and the Chinese Rescue Home, Victoria. Some of these institutions are extensively enlarging their operations, notably the French Methodist Institute in Montreal, for which large and suitable buildings have been completed in the western suburbs of the city. Rev. W. Hall, A.M., has been appointed Principal of this important institution, which is designed to accommodate 100 students.

V. Sabbath-Schools.

The number of Sabbath-schools reported last year was 2,982, and of scholars, 228,953 (increase, 5,651).

The foregoing résumé is given in order to present to the Church and to the public an idea of the extent of the educational work of Canadian Methodism. This work embraces, as we have seen, apart from Sunday-schools, 47 Mission Schools, 136 other Day Schools, 8 Colleges, and 2 Universities.
