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

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

HOW COMFORT SOAP IS MADE.

The Largest Soap Works in Canada.

YOU have probably never visited a monster soap factory, and may find it entertaining to take a short run through our manufacturing premises with us, and form a slight realization of the work entailed in "keeping Canada clean."

Our factories are situated at Toronto Junction—in the midst of a net-work of tracks of the great railways of the country—with special sidings of our own, extending to every department and annex, and of such volume that a whole train of cars can be placed at once thereon. That these great facilities are necessary is forced on the attention as one approaches the factory, it being literally surrounded with cars loaded with the products which enter into the manufacture of "Comfort" Soap. Here are huge tank cars discharging their thousands of gallons of sweet-scented cotton-seed oil

instead is loaded again just as heavily, with hundreds of boxes of "Comfort" Soap, and whirled away to its destination, which may be to the Atlantic seaboard or golden west.

Just to give you an idea of the vast size of our factories and annexes, let us tell you here that the plant occupies a floor space of over three acres. This will help you grasp the idea of the bigness of our institution.

Standing round about in the factory yards are huge iron storage and receiving tanks, with special protection covers. These great cylinders receive the oils as they arrive, and the chemically-purified lyes as they are manufactured. Steam pumps force the contents of these tanks to the top story of the main building. To this the pure white tallow is also elevated, and steamed by special process till it runs from the original packages in streams of clear limpid oil. Here, too, are carried the perfumes and other fragrant products which enter into the composition of "Comfort" Soap. Up through story after story of the factory extend enormous metal kettles which, with steam pipes coiled and radiated throughout their great interiors, compose the mechani-

cal digestors, which, open-mouthed and gaping upward, with hissing breath of steam, await the wealth of oils and fats so soon to flow into their cavernous mouths.

When all is ready, automatic gauges are adjusted, gates and valves are opened, and into these great receptacles pour tons upon tons of the assembled materials until the requisite quantity for a boiling has been forced in. It is amazing to learn that the contents of one of these kettles represent thirteen carloads of "Comfort" Soap, 300 boxes to a car, 100 cakes to the box, 300,000 bars of soap in one kettle—it is prodigious! This one kettle full of soap made into bars and stretched out end to end would extend for over twenty miles. There are seven kettles of this same huge size, and in addition many others with but a little less capacity.

The contents of these seven monster kettles, not counting the others, make seven full train loads of "Comfort" Soap.

What it means
to keep the
World Clean.

Think of seven great trains of cars all loaded with "Comfort" Soap being hauled, one after another, out from the factory yards. What a capacity! What an output! It would look as if the supply of "Comfort" Soap alone should be equal to the task of keeping the entire continent clean and sanitary, though every day were wash-day.

But to return to the great kettles in which the mass is now seething and foaming, and anon a jet spurting up here and there, like the geysers of the Yosemite. For six days the processing is maintained, and then the finished soap is left to cool down to the proper temperature, which, owing to the great volume of it,

requires about twenty days, the time being varied by the weather. After cooling it is pumped up to the third floor, and into the big steam crutchers. Pouring into them it looks not unlike golden syrup. In the crutchers it is whirled and stirred with great rapidity, and begins to assume a tawny yellow hue like pulled taffy, and one feels tempted to seize a handful and taste it, so inviting is the appearance. Here the proper perfumes are added, and when the processing is completed large frames holding 1,300 pounds each are rolled under the crutcher, a vent is opened, the golden stream flows forth, the frame is filled and rolled away, another follows, until row upon row of frames are lined up on the vast floor and left for the soap to harden.

After about four days the adjustable sides and ends of each frame are removed, leaving the great squares of soap standing upright, and ready for the cutting machine; and this soap cutter is one of the wonders of this mammoth factory. This machine seizes the great block of soap, and as easily and carefully as a mother handles her child, it trims, squares, slabs, divides crosswise and endwise, rounds, places on racks, and spreads each individual cake of soap ready for the drying room. This great machine works through the compass of two flats, and it is fascinating indeed to watch the great automaton as with precision and certainty it takes the great square of soap and hands out the finished cakes of "Comfort."

This is the only automatic steam cutting machine in the world which will take a

1,300 pound frame of soap, cut it into the size and shape of the cake of soap required, rack and spread it ready for drying in one continuous movement. It turns out 300 cakes of "Comfort" Soap per minute with a precision and certainty never at fault, and the uniformity of size and shape never varies.

After the racks are filled a carrier transfers them into the drying room. This drying room has two immense air fans continuously forcing hot air throughout its length, and as these fans make 1,500 revolutions per minute one can imagine that it feels like facing a typhoon to venture into the drying room for even a minute.

When the soap has dried out enough to allow a thin skin to form on its exterior the cakes are passed to the pressing machines, which proceed to christen each one by stamping it with its name, and as each cake emerges it is found to be smooth, hard and shining, with the name "Comfort" plain and distinct on one side, and the firm name, Pugsley, Dingman & Co., on the other.

These finished tablets are now ready for wrapping. Placed on an endless moving belt, they are carried along in front of long tables, and by an ingenious automatic arrangement are evenly distributed in front of deft-fingered girls who seize and quickly wrap them in the double costume of paraffine paper and the well-known, eagerly sought for "Comfort" wrappers. The

speed with which this wrapping is done fairly takes one's breath away, and it seems impossible that these swift moving fingers should be able to keep up the tremendous pace all the day long, filling the boxes with alternate red and white and black and white wrappers without becoming utterly wearied.

intermission takes place in the succession of these processes ; they are continuous until the cars are loaded.

After the soap has been pumped from the monster kettles the spent lye is also pumped out and forced on into the glycerine room, where, by the agency of the best machinery and process, a considerable amount of glycerine is extracted. This is used in the manufacture of dynamite and in various other economies.

In connection with this department there is a specially equipped laboratory, in charge of an expert chemist, whose duties are to supervise all the materials entering into the

As the boxes are filled they move along in automatic procession until they reach the nailing machine, where the covers are nailed on at the rate of twelve boxes per minute, four nails in each end, and six in each side of the cover. From the nailing machine the boxes are turned into a chute that lands them down stairs and into the shipping room, right abreast of the empty cars, standing on the siding ready for their load. No

manufacture of "Comfort" Soap, so as to secure their purity and uniformity, and to separate and save the valuable by-products from the spent materials, products which are usually allowed to go to waste in the ordinarily equipped soap factory.

The Power Equipment

its great fly-wheel, actionises a part of this large volume of steam, which whirls shaft, wheel and machine, while another portion enters the pipes in the big kettles for the purpose of boiling the great masses of materials making "Comfort" Soap.

Besides the great boiler battery, the powerful engine, the big stokers, and the numerous subsidiary mechanisms necessary to such a plant, there is a large capacity electric generator which lights the entire works.

A telephone system, embracing nine instruments, is required for communication for the various departments.

Every detail of this magnificently equipped factory has been thought out with the view of obtaining the "best results" and the "greatest despatch." Where such un-

preceded volumes of materials are manipulated, time is the essence of the proposition, and there must be no waste of direction, labor or effort. Each day must complete a cycle, with its beginning, its transformation, and its end, and each day the cycle is being enlarged by a steadily increasing production—to meet a steadily increasing demand. A few more

boxes each day are added, until suddenly another century of boxes of "Comfort" Soap is noted in the day's output, and the following day sees the beginning of another. Even with the latest and most expensive devices to aid labor, and economize time and space, in use, the genius of management has to be incorporated, to bring about the successful evolution of such an industrial giant.

Measure with a piece of string around the second joint of the finger for which the ring is intended. Cut off the exact length of string which encircles the finger, and place one end at 0; the figure which the other end of the string touches will be the size of ring wanted.
