Ottawa, July 9.—The attention of the Board of Control has been called to the fact that many municipal buildings are not insured at all, while others carry an insignificant amount of protection. The mayor has insisted that the city insure its property and cannot assume the responsibility of replacing any of them in the event of a fire.
