WARM DISCUSSION OF THE BAY ICE QUESTION.

Two large and warm delegations of brewers, butchers, packers and fishermen attended the meeting of the Board of Health yesterday afternoon to discuss a cool subject. Medical Health Officer Allen's edict that he intended to prohibit the cutting of ice from the bay for supply in the city was what caused the unusual gathering.

Mr. J. W. Flavelle of the Davies Packing Company could not see why his firm should be compelled to bear a tax that was imposed on those outside, as would be the case if they were prohibited from cutting ice in the bay.
