THE BIBLE CHRISTIAN MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

REPORT.

"Alleluiah, for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth." A fact declared in the sacred oracles, though largely discredited by the busy, sinning, spiritually-unobserving world, but, in the constant development of events, (as they operate to the secular advantage or disadvantage of individuals, whether occupying high or low positions among men; or result in the elevation, decline or fall of nationalities,) to the pious believer and worker, the progress of those events but indicate the march of God, as he advances,—steadily, persistently advances, in the vindication of his honor, in the assertion of his sovereign right, in the avenging of his own elect, and in the taking vengeance upon his enemies, until the promised time arrives when He, whose right it is "shall, take the kingdom and possess it forever, even forever and ever." From year to year, there is much to animate to faith and hope, and also much to stimulate to zeal and earnest effort, all who, in this world, are ranged on the Lord's side, working and fighting in reference to the better day promised of God as yet to come; and the year last past is no exception to the rule. That, against which all Christian work is opposed, is, (1st) The world at large—the world lying in wickedness; (2nd) Heathenism, including every false system, in which Christ cannot be found; (3rd) Romanism, by whatever name distinguished, as representative of priestly performances and ceremonial mummary, impiously substituted for the preaching of the Cross. Against each and all of these is evangelistic effort righteously, and only right when earnestly directed; and the result, so far, proves that, "greater is He who is with us than all that are against us"—that there is more vitality, and consequently greater aggressive power in our holy Christianity, than in any opposing system; and hence, experience supplements the Scripture testimony, and adds force to the Divine declaration, that "of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end"—that He shall have the "heathen for his inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for his possession."

The teeming millions of India's pagan population, are far less sensitive than formerly concerning Christian effort; while, with less official restriction, evangelical missionaries and operations are multiplying continually. Lord Lawrence, after a 40 years'

residence in India, has lately returned to England. At a recent Missionary Meeting in London, he said "Much as had been done for India by the English people, India was more indebted to English Missionaries than to all other classes." The following testimony of a Brahmin, at the close of a lecture by an American Missionary, lately delivered in India, shows how prejudice is diminishing: He said, "Where did the English-speaking people get all their intelligence, and energy, and cleverness, and power? It is their Bible that gives it to them. And now, they bring it to us and say, 'This is what raised us,—take it and raise yourselves.' They do not force it upon us as the Mohammedans did with their Koran; but they bring it in love, and translate it into our language, and lay it before us, and say 'look at it; read it; examine it, and see if it is not good.' Of one thing I am convinced; do what we will, oppose it as we may, it is the Christian Bible that will, sooner or later, work the regeneration of this land."

From Turkey and Persia, (and indeed the same is true of Mahometan countries generally,) just everywhere signs of coming good are daily multiplying. The missionaries, having dispersed prejudice, are becoming increasingly popular; numerous and hopeful conversions are reported; native converts, zealous for the faith in life, glory therein in persecution and trial, and through it triumph in death. Important doors are continually opening, and the missionary is permitted to enter, and is bidden welcome. All this, and much more too, indicates the Crescent's wane, and the ultimate triumph of the Cross on the sacred soil of Palestine and the East, so long under Moslem sway.

The spirit of Rome, so largely existing under a Protestant guise, is really a greater terror to evangelical laborers than Rome, as represented in the papacy. Perhaps, the Ritualistic section of the Anglican Church exerts greater power than all the propagandism of papal Rome, in perverting the clergy and people of Protestant Britain and her dependencies. State-churchism has proved the weakness, and not the bulwark of Protestantism. In Ireland, the State trammals which for centuries have cramped the action and brought reproach and blight upon the character of the Anglican Church, have been destroyed; and already the precious fruits appear, in a rejuvenated church and a cordiality of feeling among its several branches till now unknown in the history of Irish Protestantism. Already the tocsin of war upon the parliamentary church of England is heard; while the prelates repel with energy, worthy of a better cause, the onslaught of Miali and others; but the end is not yet—the full emancipation of the Episcopalian Church in England will be one of the greatest achievements the cause of Christ ever arrived at, and the extent of advantages that will

pal Rome has sustained a series of reverses during the past year,
largely counteracting her great modern successes. Scarcely had
the Council of the Vatican declared the Pope infallible, when
the French bayonets which for 20 years had kept Pius IX. in
possession of the temporal power, were withdrawn for the de-
fence of France; and, all at a blow, the Temporal power, after
1260 years' existence, has succumbed to Italian arms and the
good will of the Roman people. In the Middle Ages, the papacy
ruined Italy. In 1870, Italy returned the compliment, and over-
threw the papacy. "But for the rise of papacy, Christianity
would long since have attained a very different position in the
world; and its fall will be hailed by the living Church, when it
does come, as an unspeakable blessing—as the removal of a curse
and iniquity from the face of the earth." For the first time, the
gospel has free course in the most rigidly Roman Catholic na-
tions of Europe, and the demand for evangelical supply is far
greater than can be met. Spain, Austria, France, Italy, includ-
ing Rome, all till now exclusive as to Missionary operations, are,
at this moment centres of extensive and successful Gospel effort.
Well may we exclaim "What hath God wrought?" A compar-
ison of Romish and Evangelical Missionary liberality is a source
of great encouragement. The most extensive Romish Foreign
Missionary Society in the world, is the "Roman Catholic Soci-
ety for the Propagation of the Faith." Its seat is at Lyons, in
France. It collects from the whole of the Church, and supports
its Missionaries everywhere. It has existed nearly 50 years.
Its entire receipts last year amounted to \$1,043,418—less by
\$11,015 than in 1868. Of the \$32,839, received from North
America, \$16,219 was contributed by the British Provinces.
Catholic France, with a population one-fourth larger than Prot-
estant Britain, contributed \$735,212 for spreading their faith;
while British Protestants contributed \$2,861,735 (nearly four
times as much) for the support of nine foreign societies, and at
least \$1,000,000 more for Bible translation and distribution. It
is estimated that \$4,000,000 were collected in Great Britain last
year, and expended for religious work outside the kingdom.
As to the work in Britain, it is a most encouraging fact, that
out of 17,589 Dissenting places of worship in England and
Wales, as per certified return to the British House of Commons,
dated 1st Jan. 1870, only 853, including Roman Catholic, Mor-
mon, Jew and Unitarian, can be set down as heterodox. Among
the Evangelical churches of Britain, it is gratifying to find by the
Parliamentary Returns, that the Bible Christians have in ex-
istence 437 places of worship. The work of this Society, direct-
ly, has been, so far, in the interest of those of our own language;
in this we do a work, which, but for us, had remained undone
or, if attended to, had been so at the expense of Foreign Mis-

sions. In this we aid the great work of the world's evangelisation, inasmuch as, to the full extent of our operations, we relieve the men and means of other churches to go to foreign work, without violence to Home interests. And verily God has smiled upon us and vouchsafed us great success. New and important openings in England are being successfully occupied by the Parent Society; while the progress of our cause in Australia has astonished our most sanguine friends, and, in some instances, proved a difficulty in supplying all the men and means necessary; but the stand taken by our people in that important British dependency, reflects credit upon the Denomination, and demands gratitude to Him without whose blessing we labor in vain.

Owing to the new financial arrangement bearing heavily upon Circuits, it was feared that our Missionary receipts this year would be much reduced, and, to make the prospect still worse, the year 1870 was one of very short crops and low prices. Our adherents being largely of the farming population, we trembled for the result. Notwithstanding these difficulties, our receipts are really ahead of any previous year.

A very brief summary of the result of Missionary operations during the year, prosecuted by means of your liberality, and our work will be done.

CLINTON is reported in advance of its standing at any former period. With a deepening interest, a good Sunday School, a working Church, and an efficient ministry, the town cause would become a most flourishing one. The Parsonage debt has been cancelled.

COLBORNE reports an increase of members, resulting from a gracious revival. A new appointment has been taken up and a large class formed there. A destitute neighborhood cries for help, which, however, cannot be fully attended to, as the field is already too large for one minister to work efficiently. The societies are living in peace, finances ahead, and chapel repairs and improvements reported.

In FENELON, a new appointment has been taken up. The Mission is steadily progressing. A liberal expenditure has improved some, and freed from debt other churches. A gracious revival at the Falls has led to an enlarged society and congregation in the village. They contemplate building a Parsonage.

GREY is hopeful; but needs a young, active and devoted Missionary, to lead the Church forward in its work. There appears to be ample material, and a prospect of occupying new ground to advantage.

HUNTERFORD has sustained large loss in members by removals and unfaithfulness; but has gained financially. The labor-

HUNTINGDON is stationary, if not worse ; and will remain so until an united effort by preachers and societies place it in better circumstances to secure aggressive operation.

Unfaithfulness, associated with gross immorality, has brought reproach on the Church at INGERSOLL, and diminished its membership ; but the addition of members from the world during the year, gives a small increase on the preceding return. Despite circumstances calculated to depress, the friends are hopeful as to the future of the Station.

The young but vigorous LAKEFIELD Mission is still prosperous, and full of promise for the future. A Parsonage purchased, and a new Church in course of erection in the village, with a large amount of the cost of these already raised, are encouraging ; while the finances are steadily improving, the receipts of the year being fully equal to the disbursements.

LINDSAY.—This Mission, opened up since last Conference, has resulted in much good to the people, a gracious season of revival having given us, a large congregation, a prosperous S. School, and a membership of 94—where a year ago we had no cause whatever. A new church is ready for dedication in the village of Cambray. The prospect, at present, is all that the most sanguine could hope for ;—may nothing arise to mar it.

The LITTLE PRAIRIE Mission, Wisconsin, as we see it, is so far a failure. Our Connexional status is very little, and likely to continue so. Our membership has diminished one-half in the past year.

LONDON.—Notwithstanding the removal of many names from the list of members, the return is 29 in advance of last year. A revival at Lambeth resulted in the addition of 25 to the Society in that place. The S. School interest is encouraging; while the receipts have considerably lessened the debt on the Trust Funds, and met the expenses of the year under the new financial arrangement.

PERRYTOWN Mission is evidently improving. The Missionary reports that "about 50 have professed faith in Christ, which, after deducting those whose names have been removed, leaves an increase of 40 in the year." The finances have much improved also, and thus Perrytown, we trust, will soon begin to make return for the aid hitherto extended to it by this Society.

PICKERING has suffered much of late years owing to the breaking down of several of its Pastors; and again they have suffered from the same cause. One chapel has been bought and

paid for, and another improved very materially during the year; and although the finances are somewhat behind, the report declares that "the prospects of the Station are good, and, with the Divine blessing, we anticipate the day, not far distant, when the Station shall be taken off the list of Missions."

PRINCE ALBERT.—Membership stationary, although some have been added, making up for removals, &c. A dull year in money matters, and strenuous effort, especially on the Cartwright side, in behalf of the Williamsburg brick Church, in course of erection, have put Missionary receipts behind somewhat, although the quarterly receipts are ahead of last year. The friends are resolved to put forth a determined and united effort to make the Mission a self-sustaining Circuit,

OSHAWA.—Perhaps no mission has, in so short a time, made an equal return for labor and money invested by the Society. In the past year, the Chapel debt has diminished; while the finances, congregation, S. School, and membership have increased. An united effort will relieve the Trust of debt, and then Oshawa will support itself.

P. E. ISLAND.—Under the arrangement of last year, our work on this District has very remarkably improved, statistically, financially and spiritually. A District debt, amounting to \$260, with interest for six years accumulated, for which this Society was responsible, has been wholly discharged. In Charlottetown Circuit, the Societies and congregations are greatly strengthened by a gracious revival, in which over 100 were converted. The Church property has been improved, and 1 church is in course of erection. At Vernon River, they are building a new Church also. The Congregations are good, and the prospects encouraging. Murray Harbor is advancing. Several conversions are reported; one church improved, and another enlarged. New Bideford Church much improved. At West Devon, on the same Station, a neat church in course of erection; and other signs of prosperity appear. West Cape is somewhat encouraging, as compared with last year. The heavy debts under which all the Missions were previously laboring, have been wholly removed, save in the case of West Cape; and in this condition of comparative prosperity, four stations have asked what your Committee have readily granted, to be placed on the list of self-sustaining Circuits.

SCOTT report is desponding in tone but yet our few friends upon the Station hope the Mission will not be given up. Finances have somewhat improved on previous years; but the membership is reduced a little. We trust that steps may be initiated to render this so far unfruitful ground more productive.

The **SEYMOUR** Mission is being consolidated; and the long and much-felt want of a Chapel in the Village of Campbellford
