An Act to enable Elijah Rowell and Thomas Merrill Prime to be admitted to practice Medicine, Surgery and Midwifery.

WHEREAS, Elijah Rowell of Frelighsburg, in the County of Preamble.
 Missisquoi, and Thomas Merrill Prime of the Township of
 Brome, in the County of Brome, by their petition, have represented that they commenced the study of Medicine in Lower Canada,
 5 and subsequently completed a full course of Medical Study and received the degree of Doctor of Medicine in an incorporated School of Medicine in the United States of America; that preferring to live and practice their profession under the happy rule of Her Most Gracious Majesty, they have returned to this Province, and have further pursued
 10 the study of Medicine therein, with a view to qualify themselves for practice, but have not pursued the course of study prescribed by Law, but are prepared to undergo the examination required by Law; and have prayed that an Act may be passed authorizing such examination and enabling them to be admitted to the practice of Medicine in Lower
 15 Canada; and whereas it is reasonable and just that such prayer be granted;

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the said Elijah Rowell and Thomas Merrill
 20 Prime to present themselves before the Board of Examiners of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, without following any further course of Study; and if the said Elijah Rowell and Thomas Merrill Prime, or either of them, be found by the said examiners to be properly qualified, he or they so found qualified shall be entitled to
 25 obtain a license to practice Medicine, Surgery, and Midwifery, according to the by-laws and regulations of the said College.

E. Rowell and
 T. Merrill may
 be examined,
 and if found
 qualified, may
 be admitted
 to practice.

2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
