An Act to incorporate the Village of Newmarket.

THEREAS the great increase in the population and importance of Preamble. the Village of Newmarket since the now last census, make it expedient to provide for its incorporation as a village before the time when it could be so incorporated under the ordinary operation of the 5 Upper Canada Municipal Corporations Acts: therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Upon, from and after the first day of January, 1858, the inhabitants Newmarket of the Village of Newmarket comprised within the boundaries hereinafter incorporated named, shall be a body corporate apart from the Townships in 10 which the said Village is situate, and as such shall have perpetual succession and a Common Seal, with such powers as are now by law conferred upon Incorporated Villages in Upper Canada; and the powers of such Corporation shall be exercised by, through and in the name of the Municipality of the Village of Newmarket.

II. The Municipal Council of the Township of Whitchurch shall and Appointment 30 may, at any time after the passing of this Act, and before the first day of and duties of December next, appoint a fit and proper person to be Returning officer for Returning officer at first holding the first Municipal Election in and for the said Village of New-election. market under this Act, and in the discharge of his said duties the said Returning officer shall be governed by the provisions of the said Upper Canada 35 Corporations Acts, applicable to first election in incorporated Villages.

IV. The qualifications of electors at the first election under this Act Qualification shall be the same as those of electors at a Township election of Municipal of electors. Councillors; and the Township Clerk for the Township of Whitchurch shall lector's Roll furnish the Returning officer appointed under this Act with a certified to be furnished 40 copy of so much of the Collector's Roll for the said Township as may be required to ascertain the persons entitled to vote at the first election under this Act.

SCHEDULE.

Boundaries of the Village of Newmar ket

The said Village of Newmarket shall consist of all that part of the County of York which is bounded as follows: that is to say, commencing on the northern boundary of lot number ninety-five on the east side of Yonge street, at a point fifty chains westward from the northern boundary of the said lot, thence easterly parallel with the northern boundary of the Township of Whitchurch, one hundred chains; thence southerly parallel with the western boundary of the second concession of the said Township of Whitchurch to the southern limit of lot number thirty-two in the said second concession of Whitchurch; thence westerly along the said southern limit of lot number thirty-two to the south-west angle of said lot; thence in a right line to the south-eastern angle of lot numberninety-two in the first concession of the said Township of Whitchurch; thence along the southern limit of the said lot number ninety-two, fifty chains; thence northerly in a right line to the place of beginning.
