Business Good and Money Easy is the Verdict in B.C.

Mining Stocks Unexpectedly Active and a Spirited Demand From Toronto—The New Orphan Boy Company—News From the Sea Coast District—In Fairview Camp—The World's Special Correspondent Sends an Interesting Budget.

Vancouver, B.C., Dec. 12.—(Special Correspondence.)—Business good and money easy" is the verdict of wholesalers in British Columbia in all branches of trade. BAD WRECK AT POUCHKEEPSIE.

Fourteen Freight Cars Piled Up in a Cut—As One Was Killed.
