TWENTY-FIRST ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
TORONTO MAGDALENE ASYLUM,
OR
FEMALE HOUSE OF REFUGE.

We shall once more endeavor in this, our twenty-first annual report, faithfully to give such a statement of the results of the last year's labors as will, we hope, satisfy the friends of the institution, as well as the public generally, that it is still worthy of their support, sympathy and assistance—support in the form of annual subscriptions, sympathy and assistance in that of personal work and earnest prayer for a blessing on that work. We shall succeed, we believe, in all that pertains to the efficient management of the institution, and temporal, as well as spiritual, good of the inmates, just in proportion to the time and earnest prayerful thought we are willing to bestow upon them. Our blessed Saviour stands ready to give freely and liberally of wisdom to guide us, and blessing on our labors amongst these poor misguided ones—even to the reclaiming of many. But, alas! we are but indifferent workers, and content ourselves with but meagre results when, did we only exercise the faith we profess, "showers of blessings" might descend on both managers and inmates. The work, however, such as it is, and has been, we now proceed to lay before our readers, asking for it a thoughtful attention, and humbly offer our grateful acknowledgments to our Heavenly Father who has so graciously blessed the feeble endeavors of His professing children.

On the 1st January, 1875, there were thirty-three inmates in the Home. Since then we have admitted fifty-six, making a total of eighty-nine. Of these twenty-one have been sent to service, two married, three taken to comfortable homes by near relatives, one died, four sent to Lying-in-Hospital, twenty-three left of their own accord before the expiration of the term, viz., twelve months, leaving twenty-one in the Home 1st January, 1876.

Of those sent to service this year, comparatively few have fallen in evil courses again, certainly a less number than in former years. This would seem to indicate that we are beginning to see the fruit of

steady and persevering effort with them—not casting them aside for their first, or second, or even third fall, but encouraging them to "try again." Those taken by their friends are showing by their behaviour that the lessons learned in the Home, the influence exercised over them and the steady employment while there, have been of real and permanent benefit to them, so that we continue to receive many grateful thanks both from those taken and the friends who received them. One of these, an aged woman, met Mrs. Dunlop coming out of church, and stopping her said, "Excuse me, but I want to thank you for all that has been done for me at the Home. There is a Home up there (pointing upwards) for you, for the Home you have for us here. Till I went to it I never knew what it was to pray to God; but now, thanks be to Him, I can pray and lead a sober and useful life, and am happy with my daughter. The two who were married have gone to comfortable homes. One of them had been many years in the Home serving faithfully and steadily; the other had served three separate terms of twelve months. After each fall she returned to the Home with a determination to do better. We trust she has succeeded. The lady she was with at the time of her marriage regretted very much indeed at having to part with her. The one who died had returned to the Home time and again, always working steadily while in the Home, but falling into her drinking habits almost immediately on leaving for service. At last, after much suffering, she passed away quietly and peacefully. Most trying and unsatisfactory as her life during these last twelve years had been to those who were trying to care for her, they nevertheless are thankful that an institution such as this exists, where such as she was may have time and opportunity for repentance. Without such a Home she would most probably have been found some morning frozen to death. Surely time and money are well spent in averting an end so dreadful. As usual a large number, tired of the restraints of the Home, and possessed for the time, at least, with an insupportable desire for freedom and stimulants, insisted on leaving before the allotted term was nearly over. Yet even of these some will return and beg to be re-admitted, although they, by leaving, have forfeited whatever portion of the twelve months' probation they had served. More and more do we see that after having once been in the Home and felt the benefits of its restraints both in mind and body, they cannot lead the same kind of wretched, sinful life they used to do for any long period, and after a few years, it may be of struggles and broken resolutions, at length comes the turning point, and—the lost one is saved.

Letters and visits from former inmates who have been doing well for years continue to cheer and encourage us in our efforts, and ought to have the effect of stimulating us to increased energy in prosecuting the work carried on in the Home for the reclaiming of these poor fallen ones.

The Matron, Mrs. Aitken, is most indefatigable in her labors for the welfare of the inmates, and is deserving of much praise. Few

have any idea of the large amount of patience and forbearance, as well as firmness, she is constantly called upon to exercise while controlling their wayward and often passionate tempers. But she manages to gain their respect and in many cases their affection, and consequently her influence for good over them, both in the Home and after they leave, is very decided. She is assisted by the sub-Matron, Miss Bryson, who has charge of the workroom. A large amount of work continues to be done at the Home in washing, sewing, knitting, &c., and the sum realized this last year from that source was \$998.07. This, of course, is in addition to the labor necessary for the institution.

We have reduced the debt on the new building to \$3,000, bearing a heavy interest. We must still plead with the friends of the Home for funds to pay it off. They have dealt liberally with us hitherto, and we have no doubt will still do so, having tasted the happiness and satisfaction there is in helping on a good work.

Those gentlemen who attend to the religious services, both on the Sabbath and week days, we sincerely thank. Several of these have labored in this department of the work in the Home for years, and can testify to the blessing graciously vouchsafed on it.

Our thanks are also tendered to the physician, Dr. Geikie, who never fails to attend whenever his services are required.

And now in closing, just one word to each reader—Help us; you will never regret it.
