OUTRAGE ON CROFTS.—Two cups of cold oatmeal, mashed fine, tablespoonful butter, salt, and pepper to season, one egg. Make small cakes, fry in hot fat until crisp.

GRANB.—Three cups Graham flour, one cup wheat flour; rub into two tablespoons butter, one-half cup sugar, one beaten egg; add to this three teaspoons baking powder, a little salt, and enough water to make a soft dough. Cut out small cakes, fry in hot fat until crisp.

SOUTH PARKERS.—One pint of milk, two tablespoons of butter, four eggs, two-thirds of a cup of flour, one teaspoonful of baking powder, a little salt, and a small frying pan and pour in one-half cup of the batter; move the pan round so the batter shall cover it, and place over the fire to brown, then remove from the heat and the pancakes will rise up; spread each with marmalade or jelly, roll them up and serve with sliced lemon and sugar.

THE CARE OF THE BROOMS.—The rapidly with which brooms ordinarily wear out is surprising. This is partly due to leaving the broom standing on its end, but mostly to the use of hard, smooth, or polished handles in handling.
