Judge Snider of Hamilton Threw Out His Case

AGAINST A.L.D. McANDREW

But the Lawyers Soon Got Up Another Affidavit

Hamilton, Jan. 8.—(Special)—Martha Mason, a defeated candidate for aldermanic honors in the Sixth Ward, but now appearing as solicitor for James Phillips in an effort to oust Ald. McAndrew, received a setback today when Judge Snider of Hamilton threw out her case.

The arguments before Judge Snider this morning were replete with charges of procedural irregularities made by Mrs. Mason, but his lordship threw a bomb into camp by stating that a person making an affidavit about wrongdoing had to specify the wrongdoing at the time, and in short, to place himself in a position where he could be prosecuted for perjury unless he substantiated what he said in his affidavit.
