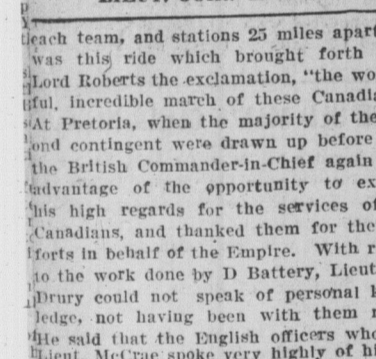

FRENCH-CANADIAN NEWSPAPER TALKS IN SEDITIOUS LANGUAGE

La Verite Pitches into Premier Ross for his Speech at the Otter Banquet—Says England Will Guard Quebec as Long as French-Canadians Say So, and No Longer.

Montreal, Jan. 11.—(Special)—A good many people blamed Mr. Tardivel of La Verite because one day he said French-Canadians should not purchase the Anglo-Protestant paper, and another in the British settlement has just come to light. In its last issue La Verite publishes a remarkable article in reply to the speech made by Hon. W. Ross, the Premier of Ontario, at the recent banquet to Col. Otter.

World Appeal to Uncle Sam. "And what will be the laudible result of a series of riots, of serious troubles, provoked by the insolence of McGill, should we have any further outbreaks of this kind? The French-Canadians have only to make a sign to Uncle Sam, and in 15 days an American army would occupy Quebec." "If, in 1877, the French-Canadians had joined themselves to the American revolutionists, it is historically certain that the British would not have thrown off the yoke of England."

Insulted Threats. Here is a summary of the climax of the article: "There is a limit to human patience. Mr. Ross says that England will always guard Quebec. Well, we think that England will guard Quebec just as long as the French-Canadians will let her do so."

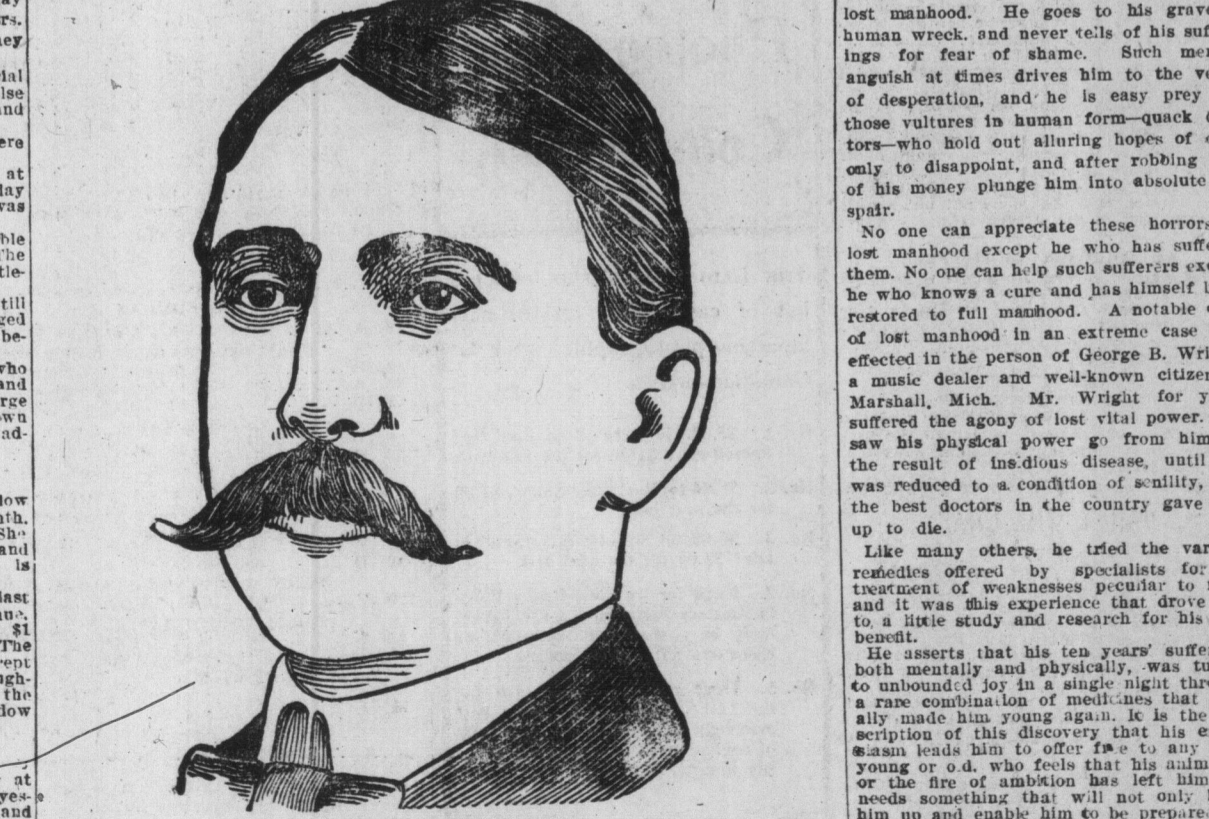
