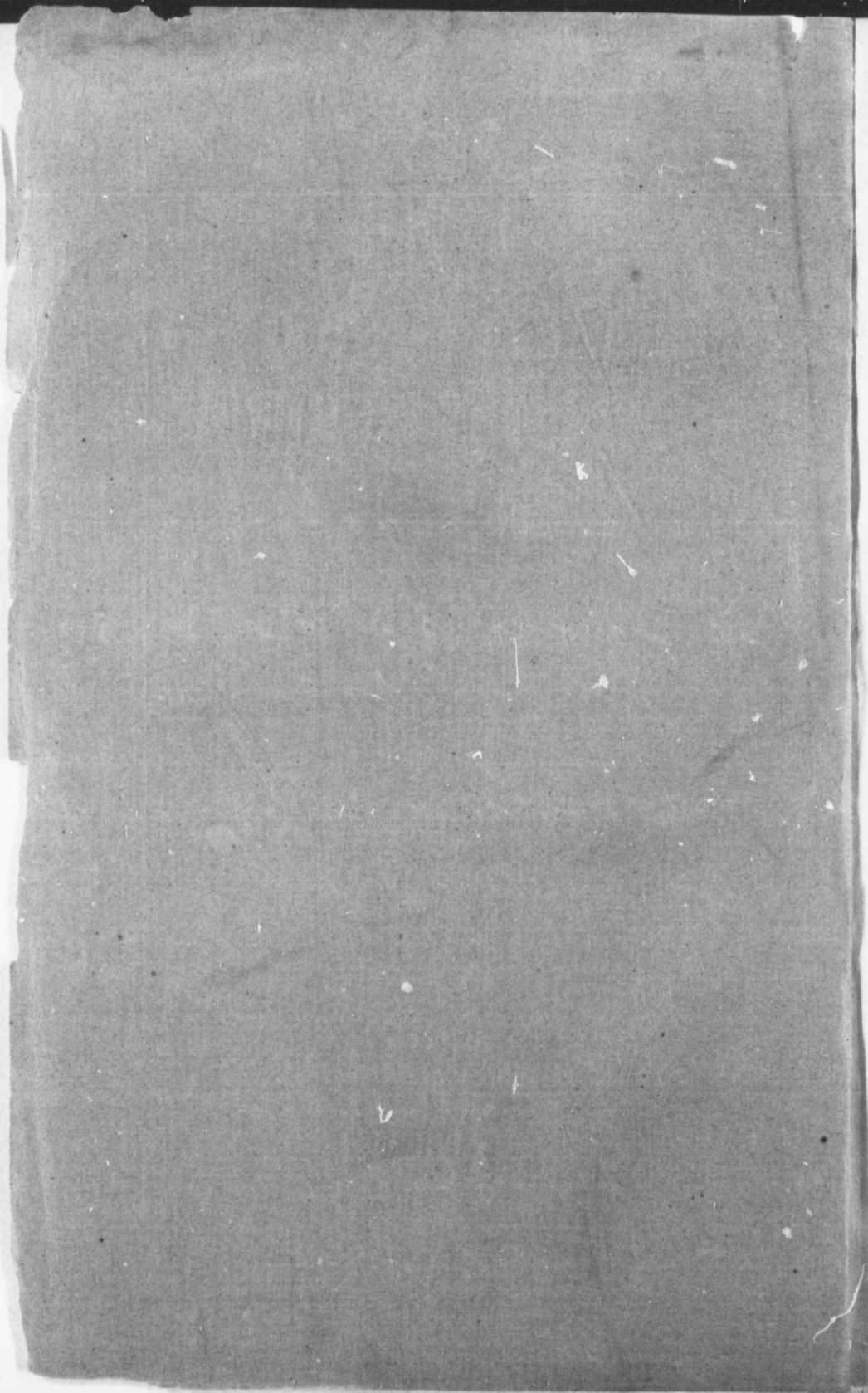

RESOLUTION OF COMMITTEE.

“That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the missions; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done; and in order to do this, missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previously to the meeting of the Committee; and in case any of the Missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hopes that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the good of the mission work.”

The Quarterly Meeting of these Committees shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, the 3rd of August, and Thursday, the 2nd of November, 1876; Thursday, the 1st of February, and Thursday, the 3rd of May, 1877. Each Meeting to commence at 9 o'clock a.m.

REPORT.

ADDRESS OF THE GENERAL MISSIONARY COMMITTEE.

To the Ministers, Collectors and Friends of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada :

DEAR BRETHREN AND FRIENDS :—It affords us pleasure again to address you on the great subject of the spread of the religion of our Divine Lord. Since the last report was issued, seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, and months have passed—how small they have appeared ! but by their flight another year has rolled round. As the moments have fled they have been passing witnesses of our conduct in relation to the all important matter of extending the Kingdom of Jesus Christ, and have borne before the great white throne their report of that conduct. The work of God's people in connection with His cause is not overlooked. His eye sees it all ; and His hand writes it down. Their patient suffering, their earnest toil, their willing sacrifice, their cheerful liberality,—all their services of faith and love are registered in heaven, the recording angel misses nothing. What encouragement to work in such a cause and for such a master ! and when we look at the work itself, the cause to which our energies are devoted, there is equal encouragement to pray, and work, and give, and if need be, suffer for its advancement. When Garibaldi undertook the cause of Italy he appealed to his countrymen to join his standard, promising them privation, suffering, hard toil, wounds and bruises, and probably death on the battle field ; but at the end, a united Italy—a free country ; and with such an object as this to gain, he considered that no suffering or toil should daunt Italians. The cause of Christian Missions is infinitely more glorious than that of the great hero—the cause of God—of myriads of human souls bought by the blood of Jesus. Other enterprises there are which deserve our attention, and justly claim our support, seeing they have for their object the happiness and elevation of our race. But we can conceive of no enterprise which so effectually promotes that happiness and elevation as that which sends the messenger of God to a fallen world, with the Word of Life in his hand, and the story of the Cross as his theme. Other philanthropic enterprises do much to alleviate human suffering and to assuage human misery, and thus they are the handmaids of religion and worthy of patronage. But Christianity not merely brings relief to the human race, by materially lessening its sufferings. It does not strike merely at effects, but strikes directly at the great cause of human misery. By destroying sin, it destroys the cause, and the effects cease. It does not merely lop off the branches of this baneful tree—sin—but seeks to uproot it from the

hearts of men, and thus effectually destroy it; and by removing the only barrier to communion with God, and giving to the souls of men a knowledge of Christ as the way to God, effectually saves and makes them happy. Such are the blessed results of Christian teaching—results which Christianity alone can accomplish. If other enterprises accomplish good, they do so just in proportion as they are imbued with the spirit of Christ. If they possess power for good, that power is derived either directly or indirectly from Christianity. It is as a sun round which they all revolve as their centre—it is the soul of them all. The Gospel makes known to the world God's great remedy for the souls of men. God has committed into the hands of the Church that Gospel with the commission to carry it to all the nations. That commission is world-wide. The Church has put upon her in this matter great honor, and also great and solemn responsibility. She is made the steward of great riches—riches to be dispensed to a destitute world.

As a section of the Christian Church, God has entrusted us with a measure of this great work. He has said to us "Go work in my vineyard!" "Preach the Word!" "Be instant, in season and out of season!" A dispensation of the Gospel is committed unto us. As a people we have duties and responsibilities in relation to this great work of saving the world. Those who are blessed with qualifications for preaching the Gospel, God expects them to do it. Those who have not the qualifications necessary to preaching, doubtless have talents which fit them for working in some department of the Church's varied spheres of activity, and God expects all to find their own work and to do it, so that with consistency they may expect one day to hear the Master say "Well done."

Those who are helpers in the cause of God very naturally desire to hear of its prosperity. The past year has witnessed many a hard-fought battle on the spiritual battle-field, and also many a glorious victory. There has been much hard labor; and though, as is usually the case, it may appear in some respects that the results are not equal to the labor bestowed, yet there have been blessed results, and it must be borne in mind that in no case does the fruit appear all at once. Often there are immediate results. At other times souls may carry conviction received under the preaching of the Word for long, and yet it may result in salvation. As bread cast upon the waters, it may be seen after many days. Thus there is encouragement to work on, trusting in God, who has said His word shall not return unto Him void. During the year that has just closed, however, God's servants on many fields of labor have been encouraged in the immediate results of their work. Many conversions have been witnessed, and hundreds of souls gathered into the Church, and the Lord's workers have thanked God and taken courage.

The English Missionary Report as usual, gives evidence of earnest labor and enlarged success. It would be pleasing to our readers to have many extracts from it. But space will not permit. We may, however, venture on a few references and short extracts from it. It says:—

in our Sunday-schools of teachers and scholars. Our increase on the Mission Stations, Home, Colonial, and Foreign, is 1718. We have built 13 new chapels and 7 new schools; 23 new Sabbath-schools have been commenced; more than 4,000 open-air services have been conducted, and more than 24,000 pastoral visits have been made to the homes of the people. The missionaries have preached the Gospel in the open streets and public market places; they have cried in the chief places of concourse from house to house. They have entered the homes of the neglected and neglectors; have gone into the dens of depravity and abysses of human misery to save souls from being 'drowned in perdition.' They have seen the impenitent become contrite, drunkards converted into sober men, the home of the wretched and wicked transformed into a bower for song, and a temple for worship. There has been joy in heaven and on earth in beholding many souls during the year raised to a higher social, mental and moral position. They are gems from which the foul incrustations of sin have been washed away. They may now be seen glowing with the hues of Christian graces; and of them we have hope that they will adorn the diadem of the world's Redeemer. At Aldershot, the great military depôt, we have built a school-room and house for the minister; the chapel is in course of erection. Several soldiers have been converted, among them three young men, sons of ministers. The London Missions report progress. We have bought a good chapel in a good situation in Southwark, from the Catholic Apostolic Church; we have taken the far-famed Surrey Chapel for the remaining five years of the lease. But we need financial help to sustain and extend our labors in London. It is a nation in itself. Here we have millions of souls, of whom hundreds of thousands are 'without Christ.' To reach them we need no voyage across the stormy sea, or journey through a wild inhospitable country."

"The Missionaries are happy in their work, and the committee is strongly urged to appoint more agents on fresh ground, where doors of usefulness appear open before us. About twenty more missionaries are asked for the Colonies, four more are asked for Africa, and many for the large towns and mining and manufacturing districts of this country. And then we have millions of immortal souls in London, the metropolis of England, the influence of which is felt everywhere. Were London converted to God, it would be a great step to the conversion of the world. For London we need men full of faith and the Holy Ghost, and we need money for suitable sanctuaries in which we may worship and labor. The Connexion grows in wealth, in numbers, and in influence. Our church property has increased fully half a million sterling in the last few years; our Sunday-school scholars are about 330,000. Then with 176,000 members, a host of local preachers, class leaders and Sunday-school teachers and friends, what might not be done if well organized, and rightly affected by the claims of Jesus and the needs of the world. The cause is yours: you have to carry the gospel into every nation, beginning at home first with its riches of pardon, peace, and holiness: with its counsels, consolations and hopes for all people."

At Aldershot, a great military depôt, some time since, a Primitive Methodist Missionary commenced religious services in a public house, known as the "Jolly Farmer;" the object being to preach the Word to the soldiers. A number have been converted, a good society and also Sabbath-school raised. A good church is being erected, in reference to which the following is taken from the English Report:

"We have a still more extensive field of operation in the town and camp of Aldershot. Early in 1875 we opened our school-room, which is now used as a temporary church, and on March 22nd, 1876, we laid the memorial stones of

our Rotunda Mission Church, when Mrs. Henry Hodge, of Hull, Miss Beckworth of Leeds, Mr. Wm. Francis of Ramsgate, Wm. Allden, Esq., Mr. W. Manley, and our tried friend, Mr. Samuel Terry, of Aldershot, each laid memorial stones, and liberally helped our funds, which, with collections on this date realized £250. The building is steadily progressing, and we hope by the end of this year to open it for divine worship. The cost of the entire premises will be £2,000. We have had a good work going on in the town of Aldershot, where many trophies have been won for Christ. The Rev. A. Beable, the second preacher, who lives in Aldershot, has been almost exclusively devoted to mission work, both among civilians and soldiers during the year. We submit extracts from his journal:—

The following are cheering examples of the success attending these labors among the soldiers of the English Army:

"The temptations to drink and sin are to be found on every hand, in camp and in town; and a soldier to be a *Christian* needs much courage and grace to carry out his convictions and live as he should live. A soldier's missionary needs, too, much grace and help from God to bear defeat as well as success. Many of the dear fellows when put to the test give up in despair; but there are many noble specimens of Christian courage and fortitude, many are indeed—

"Brands plucked from the Burning"

"W. G. was a drunken, dissipated youth a private in one of the Infantry Regiments, who, while in Jersey, was so addicted to drink, that he was often in trouble. His colonel requested him to sign the pledge that he would draw no more pay while on the Island of Jersey, where they were then lying. He came to this camp, and while here I met him, invited him to our Wednesday service, and he found the Lord most gloriously. He is now in India, holding on his way and is useful for God. His letters to me are a pleasure to read.

"G. M. was a drunken soldier, on a foreign station, often under religious impressions, and as often drowning conviction by drink. He returned to this country, heard God's word preached, and with many tears sought the Saviour. He is now most useful, mighty in prayer, and zealous for God.

"A. E. T. was convicted at one of our meetings. Gradually the Lord opened his heart, and he attended to the concerns of his soul. He was so happy in his new found joy that he attracted the attention of a comrade, who while on guard, opened his heart to this brother, who was delighted to point him to Jesus, whom he at once embraced as his Saviour. They are both consistent members of our church. It is pleasing to see them together in our love-feasts, &c.

"Our public services at Aldershot are well attended. Soldiers are now paraded to church in charge of a non-commissioned officer. It is an interesting sight to see a crowd of soldiers from different regiments drinking in the Word of Life. Many have been brought to God by our labours. We keep a pledge book always open upon our little table in front of the platform, and many have enrolled their names in the temperance army. We have two regular open-air stands, where we preach the Word to the multitude. We have much that is difficult and up-hill, but God is with us, and we are prospering. We have a great undertaking in erecting our Rotunda Church, etc., and need a great deal of assistance."

The work in the Australasian Colonies is rapidly progressing. Fields of usefulness are entered, and success crowns the labors of God's servants. The African mission is expensive and laborious, and trying to the health of the missionaries, and advancement among the heathen slow; but perseverance, faith

and prayer, and holy living, and Christian example, before the natives will win Fernando-Po for God. On the African Continent the Missionary Committee has many openings for usefulness; and it is an honor and a blessing to the Connexion itself to be permitted to take part in a work so great and glorious as that of bringing benighted Africa to Christ and the enjoyment of His salvation. We would like to have made some extracts, but want of space forbids.

God in His mercy continues to smile upon us and bless us in this our beloved country. Last year was one of spiritual and numerical prosperity. Many blessed revivals were experienced on many of our stations. At Conference nearly all reported increases, so that, as the tabular views show, on the whole work a good increase is the result. A case or two may be noted as to how graciously the Lord has blessed the labours of His servants. St. Catharines: in this town the work commenced at the Conference of 1874, two years since. At the Conference of 1875 they reported 40 members, a good and successful year's work. At last Conference they report 88 members. Land has been purchased, and a neat and commodious church built, and though there is a debt, the church is in easy circumstances. (It is right to say that in the church building some outside help has been received thankfully). A good Sabbath School has been raised up, and we trust this new mission has before it a prosperous future.

At the Conference of 1875, Three Mile Lake Mission was formed by striking off a few places from the Muskoka Station, with a membership of about 25. They experienced gracious outpourings of the Holy Spirit, many souls were saved and added to the Church, and to last Conference they reported an increase of 53 members. These are, indeed, encouraging cases of spiritual and numerical growth, and though not to the same extent, a number of other stations have been similarly blessed, and the confidence of the people in the great mission God has given us has been increased, and to Him from whom all good cometh, and by whom all blessing is bestowed, the praise is given.

On a few of the stations there has not been experienced the same spiritual influence and converting power, and the reports do not indicate the same progressiveness. It is to be hoped that in these cases this experience is but the dark hour before a glorious sunrising and a prosperous day.

The Committee continues to receive appeals for help in extending the work of God, which it finds it difficult or impossible to comply with for want of the means. Some stations wish to extend their borders where they have good openings, and others appeal for new stations to be formed, but the Committee is unable to comply with these earnestly expressed wishes as their financial resources do not at present permit them. We think it well to let these facts be known, and trust that the friends of this good work will come forward and liberally lay upon the missionary altar sufficient to enable the Missionary Committee and Conference to give a favorable response to the calls referred to above.

The following is in a brief form the financial statement for the past year, ending June 30th, 1876 :

Deducting the Income from the Expenditure, it will be seen that the latter exceeds the former by \$908 68; adding the excess of disbursements last year, viz: \$317 46, and the excess for two years will be found to be \$1,226 14—an average of over \$600 00 each year. Now, it will be quite evident to the supporters of this cause, that things cannot continue thus. Had the contributions from the Stations come up to the amount last year's Report appealed for, viz: \$10,000 00, the balance would have been a much more favorable one. The above facts and remarks will make it clear how necessary it is to renew the appeal, and how desirable it is that the amount should be realized—\$10,000 00—the coming year. Will our brethren the ministers, and our devoted and self-sacrificing friends the collectors, unite in counsel and effort for the purpose of securing this amount, the coming year; and if they set about it in a thoroughly earnest manner, we have no doubt the generous contributors will see to it that the effort shall be a success.

It will be seen that our English Conference continues to treat us in the same kind and liberal manner as in the past, having sent us £600 last year, and for the present year they have voted us the same amount, and in addition, £50 towards the Montreal Mission. To them our hearty thanks are due, and are freely offered.

And now, dear friends, this important matter affecting, possibly, thousands of souls, is before you once more. It is hoped it will have your thoughtful attention—pray for Divine direction in reference to your relationship to this cause, and your obligations to it as the cause of God, the cause which has been a blessing to you, to your families, and to thousands of people throughout this favored land. In the closing language of the English Report we conclude:—

“What can you do? and what will you do for Jesus? He asks you to give your influence, your example, your prayers, your hearts, into His possession, and your life for His service, that you may honor Him with your substance and the first-fruits of your increase. Jesus is worthy—His cause is worthy! Then let your liberality keep pace with your ability, your duty and your obligations. ‘Freely ye have received—freely give;’ not a little from much, but much from little—your life, your soul, your all.”
