CHICAGO'S SENSATION.

THE GREAT CRIMINAL MURDER TRIAL OPENED AT LAST.

Attorney Longenecker Outlines the Case for the Government, and Makes a Powerful Argument in a Crowded Court Room.

CHICAGO, Ill., Oct. 24.—The iron steps leading up to the Dearborn street building could not hold all the persons who clamored for admission to the Cronin trial this morning. Men and women were wedged together on the sidewalk to gain a foothold on the steps, and for a block on Dearborn street people on their way to work stopped to watch the frantic effort.

The court room was filled with a mass of the curious spectators banded about the doorway. The bailiffs had instructions to prevent the crowd from entering the courtroom, and to eject all suspicious looking persons. The officers made a bold fight for a time, but were eventually overborne by numbers. Then the throng for the courtroom began. Within 20 minutes every seat in the room was occupied, and a hundred men were fighting for a place to stand. The benches at the Dearborn street side were filled with women who came early to see the trial. The men were crowded out of the courtroom, and many of them were sitting on the sidewalk.
