THE NEW BAGDAD RAILWAY TEMPORARY BRIDGE OVER THE EUPHRATES NEAR CARCHEMISH, THE ANCIENT HITTITE METROPOLIS.

The bridge is about a mile long, and is to be replaced by a permanent masonry and steel bridge to cost 3,000,000f, and requiring three years to complete. Some fears are felt as to whether the present temporary one will stand securely in the heavy Euphrates floods. The lives of Jesse and Frank James, those notorious outlaws, read like some five cent thriller. Jesse James was killed by members of his own band and Frank is now at the point of death.

Their father was Robert James, a Baptist preacher, who was persecuted by his Union neighbors during the civil war because his sympathies were with the South. In order to get revenge Jesse and Frank joined the guerrillas and they soon earned a name for reckless daring.

In 1866 Jesse was outlawed and with his brother attained a world wide notoriety by the crimes they committed, by their romantic adventures, and their impost invariable success. A reward of \$10,000 was offered for the capture of Jesse and, tempted by the bribe, two of his band killed him. A short time after Jesse's death Frank gave himself up. Now Frank is dying and the history of the "James boya" will soon be ended.


