## BILL.

An Act to repeal the laws relating to  
Winter Roads in Lower Canada.

**W**HEREAS experience hath shewn the Preamble.  
inefficacy and impracticability of the  
ordinances relating to winter roads, which  
enact that no cariole, sleigh, berline or other  
5 winter vehicle, other than the sleighs or  
*trainaux* designated in the said ordinances,  
shall be used on the Queen's highways or  
public roads in Lower Canada:—Be it there-  
fore enacted, &c.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority  
of the same, That from and after the passing  
of this Act, the Ordinance of the Legislature  
of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed  
in the Session held in the third and fourth  
15 years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled:

*"An Ordinance to provide for the improve-  
ment, during the winter season, of the Queen's  
Highways in this Province, and for other  
purposes,"*—and the Ordinance of the said  
Ordinances of  
Special Coun-  
cil, 3 and 4  
Vict. c. 25,

20 Legislature passed in the fourth year of Her  
Majesty's Reign, and intituled: *"An Ordi-  
nance to amend the laws relative to winter  
roads,"*—and the Act passed in the sixth  
year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled:

25 *"An Act to amend two certain Ordinances  
therein mentioned, relative to winter roads  
in that part of Province formerly called  
Lower Canada,"*—and the Act passed in the  
Session held in the tenth and eleventh years  
Acts of Cana-  
da 6 Vict.  
c. 12,

30 of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: *"An  
Act to suspend for a certain time two cer-  
tain Ordinances therein mentioned, relating  
to winter roads in that part of the Province  
of Canada heretofore Lower Canada, in so  
35 far as regards the District of Quebec, the  
District of Gaspé, and that part of the Dis-  
"*  
and 10 and 11  
Vict. c. 40,  
&c. repealed.

*“ District of Three Rivers which extends from the  
“ District of Quebec on the South of the River  
“ St. Lawrence, to the Parish of Nicolet, and  
“ on the North of the said River to the Town  
“ of Three Rivers, exclusively,”* and generally 5  
all other Acts or Ordinances suspending,  
amending, or continuing the said Acts or Or-  
dinances or any of them, and all Acts or Or-  
dinances repealed by the said Acts or Ordi-  
nances or any of them, shall be and the same 10  
are hereby repealed.
