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## Rome in Its Ancient Splendour.

Another millboard of exactly the same size being fastened on the top interior, with a linen hinge, and falling down forms a bevelled mount, through which the picture may be seen to great advantage. The method, the material used, and the workmanship being the best. The above comprises the choicest productions of Mr. TurNEA, including many fine specimens of landscape and marine scenery never previously engraved.
