Address by the Honourable Monique Vézina, Minister for External Relations, at the opening of National Forum Africa

OTTAWA February 13, 1986. MOMENTS LIKE THIS COME FAR TOO SELDOM IN THE LIFE OF A MINISTER. IN CARINET COLLEAGUES WOULD AGREE WITH ME WHEN I SAY THAT IN OUR 'METIFP' IT IS PAPE INDEED TO PEACH THE CULMINATION OF A PROCESS, TO PEACH THAT POINT WHERE ONE CAN MEASURE THE RESULTS OF ONE'S ACTIONS, AND IN DOING SO, TO BE PEPAID A HUNREDFOLD.

FIFTEEN MONTHS HAVE CONE BY STACE NOVEMBER 1001, WHEN I MADE MY FIRST OFFICIAL VISIT TO ENTIOPIA. AND SINCE THAT TIME, SO INVITATINGS HAVE HAPPENED! SO MANY CANADIANS HAVE RESPONDED TO THE CALL FOR HELP!
TODAY'S EXHIBITION TELLS THE STORY MOST ELOQUENTLY. THESE PICTURES SPEAK TO US. THEY PEMILID US OF MAST WAS, AND OF THE RESCUE OPERATION THAT INVOLVED US ALL.

IT IS MY HOPOUR TODAY TO PAY HOMMAGE TO ALL THOSE MEDIAND MOMEN WHO TOOK PART. IT IS MY RESPONSIBLITY TO EMODERAGE CANNOTANG TO CONTINUE IN THIS PATH. AND IT IS MY RESPONSIBILITY TO TELL THEM OF THE ACTIONS AND INTENTIONS OF OUR GOVERNMENT.

NOT TOO LONG AGO, THE INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY CO-ORDINATOR,
MAURICE STRONG, SPEAKING IN LONDON ABOUT THIS PELIFE OPERATION, COMPARED
IT TO A WAR EFFORT IN A TIME OF PEACE. AND INDEED, WHAT TOOK PLACE WAS
AN ALL-OUT MOBILISATION OF FEFORT, WHERE CANADA STOOD OUT FOR HER
UNPARALLELLED GEMEPOSITY.

AS A QUEREC JOURNALIST PUT IT, WE APE PEPHAPS A PEOPLE CUSTOM-MADE TO HELP AFRICA. WITH ALL OUP RESOURCES AND OUR WEALTH, WE COULD BE THE BIGGEST EGOISTS IN THE WOPLD. BUT PIGHT FROM THE BEGINNING, WE PAVE PETAINED OUP SENSE OF SOLIDARITY.

PECENT POLLS SHOW JUST HOW MUCH CAMADIANS CAPE APOUT THE PROBLEM OF HUNGER IN THE WORLD. OF ALL THE STATISTICS, I AM PARTICULARLY MOVED BY THE FACT THAT FORTY-FOUR PER CENT OF ALL PESPONDENTS WHOSE INCOME WAS LESS THAN \$10,000 GAVE TO HELP APPLICA.

THOSE PEOPLE WERE AMONG THE MORE THAN 800,000 CANADIANS WHOSE DONATIONS TOTALLED SOME \$60 MILLION. THIS MONEY, MATCHED BY THE GOVERNMENT, CAME ERCH TOWNS AND EPOM SCHOOLS, FROM PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENTS AND EACTORY WORKERS, FROM GROUPS AND ASSOCIATIONS OF ALL KINDS. FROM VANCOUNER, WHERE ONE MILLION DOLLARS WERE COLLECTED, TO HALIFAX, WHERE THE ETHIOPIA AIPLIET TRANSPORTED ESSENTIAL GOODS TO ETHIOPIA. OUR APTISTS AND OUR JOURNALISTS HELPED BY KEEPING THE CRISIS EVER PRESENT IN OUR HEAPTS. AND AT THE SAME TIME, IN AFRICA, PEOPLE WERE WORKING IN THE MIDST OF THE DESOLATION, LIVING IN DAILY CONTACT WITH THE SUFFERING, WORKING AGAINST FATIGUE AND EPUSTPATION AND THE LIMITATIONS OF WHAT COULD BE

THE CHALLENGE FACED BY THE GOVERNMENT WAS TO TRANSFORM THIS FLOOD OF MONEY, OF IDEAS, OF PROJECTS AND EMERGY, INTO AN OPGANIZED AND EFFICIENT OPERATION. IT WAS THE CHANCE TO PUT OUR PRINCIPLES TO THE TEST. FOR THE FIRST TIME, A NON-GOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE WAS GIVEN THE PESPONSIBILITY OF ALLOCATING PUBLIC MONEY FOR AID. THIS COMMITTEE

CAPRIED OUT ITS DUTIES WITH ADMIPABLE PESULTS, UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF THE FEDERAL CO-OPDIMATOR, DAVID MACDONALD, TO WHOM I PAY HOMMAGE THIS AFTERNOON.

BUT RELIEVING THE VICTIMS OF THE FAMILIE WAS JUST THE BEGINNING.

LAST SEPTEMBER 4TH, IN OTTAWA, I REMINDED CANADIANS THAT "WHAT HAPPENED IN AFPICA MUST NOT HAPPEN AGAIN. ON THAT DAY I LAUNCHED FORM AFPICA, WHICH PEPPESENTED THE SECOND PHASE OF THE MANDATE OF DAVID MACDONALD.

THE APPICAN PEOPLES STILL LIVE WITH THE DANGED. WE HAVE TO KNOW THAT, AND WE MUST KEEP PEPEATING IT. AND THAT IS THE MAIN PEASON FOR THIS SEPIES OF MEETINGS AND EVENTS OPGANIZED JOINTLY BY LOCAL AND PEGIONAL GROUPS, AND OUR CO-OPDINATOR.

A SPECIAL THANKS TO ALL THOSE WHO TOOK PAPT, I AM THINKING OF THE SCHOOL IN WHITEHORSE WHICH LENT ITS FACILITIES, AND OF THE YUKON COMPANY (NORTHWEST TEL) WHICH PROVIDED TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT, I AM THINKING OF THE JOURNALISTS, WHO GAVE DEPTH AND INSIGHT TO THE DISCUSSIONS, AND OF THE SCHOOLCHILDREN OF CALGARY WHOSE SONG DEMONSTRATED THEIR SENSE OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE CHILDREN OF THE THIRD WORLD. I AM THINKING OF THE OPGANIZERS OF THE "MARRIE D'AFRIQUE", THE AFRICA TUESDAYS IN SHERBROOKE, AND OF THE SERIOUS INTEREST OF THE HALIFAX ACADEMIC COMMUNITY... AND OF SO MANY OTHERS.

ON BEHALE OF THE GOVERNMENT, THANKS TO ALL THOSE MEN AND WOMEN WHO PAPTICIPATED IN THESE MEETINGS, AND TO THOSE WHO OPGANIZED THEM.

FORUM AFRICA HAS BEEN PART OF THE CONSULTATION PROCESS UNDERTAKEN IN THE CONTEXT OF OUR REVIEW OF FOREIGN POLICY. WE WANTED TO GIVE THE FLOOP TO CANADIANS WHO WERE INVOLVED IN PECENT MONTHS IN THE AFRICAN CRISIS.

THEIR CONTRIBUTION WILL BE INVALUABLE TO THE PARLIAMENTARIANS WHO ARE CHARGED WITH MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT.

LAST YEAP, FORTY PER CENT OF OHP AID BURGET WAS DIPECTED AT AFRICA —
THAT IS ABOUT EIGHT HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS. WE INSISTED THAT
INTERNATIONAL OPGANIZATIONS PUT THE PRIORITY ON AGRICULTURE, AND ON THE
NEED TO COORDINATE INTERNATIONAL FEFORTS.

PUT ABOVE ALL, WE LISTENED TO APPICA. OUR ANTENNAE WERE OUT. DUPING MY VISITS TO APPICA, I MET WITH SEVERAL HEADS OF STATE. SIMILARLY, DAVID MACDONALD TRAVELLED TO APPICA ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS. LAST SUMMER, HERE IN OTTAWA, PERRESENTATIVES FROM EACH OF THE REGIONS STRICKEN BY THE DROUGHT PRESENTED THEIR ANALYSIS OF THE SITUATION TO A SYMPOSIUM ON THE APPICAN DROUGHT. AND, IN A FEW DAYS, THE SUMMET OF EPANCOPHONE HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT LEADERS WILL COME TOGETHER TO DISCUSS THE PROPLEMS OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION IN APPICA.

TWOULD LIKE AT THIS POINT TO SAY HOW HOMOURED WE ARE TO HAVE WITH US TODAY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY,

MP INF OUMAROU, WHO WILL TAKE PART IN THE NATIONAL FOREM AFRICA

PROCEEDINGS.

THUS, SLOWLY BUT SUPELY, A VAST PROGRAMME OF PECOVERY IS BEING OUTLINED -- A PROGRAMME IN WHICH CANADA WILL PLAY HER PART.

CONFRONTED WITH THE GPEAT NUMBER OF DECISIONS TO BE TAKEN, MY UNDERLYING PRINCIPLE IS THAT WE MUST NEVER LOSE SIGHT OF THE ULTIMATE OBJECTIVE:

FOOD SELE-SUFFICIENCY: AND OF THE FACT THAT IN OPDER TO ACHIEVE FOOD SELE-SUFFICIENCY, WE MUST WORK AT ALL LEVELS.

WE HAVE TAKEN THE FIRST MAJOR STEP, IN THAT WE HAVE REALIZED THE GRAVITY OF THE SITUATION... OUR POLE IS TO ENCOURAGE, TO SHAPE, TO HELP GOVERNMENTS AND PEOPLE THEMSELVES TO MAKE THE NECESSARY CHANGES. ECOLOGICAL PEDRESS, INCREASE IN FOOD PRODUCTION, THESE THINGS WILL ONLY HAPPEN IF ACTION IS TAKEN ON ALL EPONTS: AGRICULTURAL AND RESEARCH POLICIES; TRAINING AND EDUCATION OF PEOPLE; AID IN PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES...

THPOUGH DIALOGUE, THPOUGH ASSISTANCE, WE INVITE APPICAN GOVERNMENTS TO PEFORM THEIR AGRICULTURAL POLICIES. WITH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, WE ENCOURAGE RESEARCH. APPICAN AGRICULTURE COULD BENEFIT GREATLY FROM NEW TYPES OF SEEDS THAT ARE BETTER ADAPTED TO THE ENVIRONMENT, AND FROM APPROPRIATE AGRICULTURAL METHODS AND TECHNIQUES. TO THIS FAIL WE ENCOURAGE INTERNATIONAL COORDINATION OF EFFORT, AND OUR OWN.

INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT RESEARCH CENTER (IDRC) PLAYS AN IMPORTANT POLE IN THIS FIELD. WE ALSO BELIEVE IT IS ESSENTIAL TO TRAIN APPICAN PESEARCHERS AND TECHNICIANS, AS WELL AS TO UNDERTAKE A PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMME.

IN THE SHOPT TEPM, IN OPDEP TO INCPEASE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION, WE MUST SUPPLY FERTILIZERS, SEEDS, AND TOOLS. TO ENCOURAGE THE FARMERS THEMSELVES, WE MUST INVEST ABOVE AND BEYOND PRODUCTION... WITHOUT

PEROPESTATION MUST TAKE PLACE.

BUT THE PEASANT HIMSELF, AND HERSELF, MUST BE THE PPIME MOVED IN THIS STRATEGY. WE MUST PELV ON THE HUMAN POTENTIAL OF AFPICA, AS WELL AS ON THE ABILITIES AND THE COMMITMENT OF CANADIANS WHO APE WOPKING TOWAPDS THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CONTINENT. AND THE POLE OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL.

OPGANIZATIONS HAS BECOME OF SPECIAL IMPOPTANCE IN THIS PROCESS.

IT IS MY CONVICTION THAT PEAL DEVELOPMENT IS NOT A METAMORPHOSIS PHT AN EVOLUTION - A SLOW EVOLUTION, I WILL ADD. THAT MUST DEPEND FIRST AND FOREMOST ON HUMAN PESOUPCES.

AND THUS, WE NEED THE PAPTICIPATION OF ALL MEN AND WOMEN.

THAT IS WHAT I ASK OF YOU.

THAT IS WHAT I HOPE FOR AFRICA.

IT IS WITH GPEAT PLEASUPE AND ANTICIPATION, THEPEFOPE, THAT I WELCOME YOU HERE TO THE NATIONAL FORM AFRICA. I WISH YOU A USEFUL MEETING, AND I LOOK FORWARD TO THE PESULTS OF YOUR DELIBERATIONS.
