

Beach Control, Good Roads and Curbing Were the Principal Topics Discussed.

BOARD OF WORKS AND SEWERS.

Erskine Church Will Probably Call Rev. R. Martin of Markham—General News.

Hamilton, Ont., May 14.—(Special.)—The City Council met tonight, and during the course of a not very lengthy session talked principally of beach control, good roads and curbing.

When the report of the Harbor and Beach Commission was presented, the mayor of the Board of Works and Sewers, Ald. Ten Eyck, protested against the report going through. The committee's recommendations meant the expenditure of a lot of money, and the committee had no money to spend. He thought the Mayor ought to rule the report out of order, as transgressing the limits concerning expenditures.

Ald. Neilgan, as a once chairman of the Harbor Committee, expressed his admiration for the committee's proposals. It was anxious and willing to improve the resort, and saw there were some who wished to take his powers away.

Ald. Feanade, the committee's chairman, stood manfully by his report. It was right in every particular, and the members were going to support the recommendations. Ald. Menden and Ald. Frenchie objected to the going away of the sprinkler for an electric street.

Ald. Feanade said he respected an opinion from the City Solicitor respecting the committee's powers, and he thought that opinion was right in some ways and wrong in others. The committee, he said, wanted an independent legal opinion.

Ald. Evans advocated a proper definition of the powers of the committee and the Parks Board. He understood, however, that legal opinion, so far as the control of the Parks Commission and the Beach, was that the two bodies met and come to some understanding.

Ald. Eikon and Ald. Pettigrew moved an amendment to refer the report back to the committee, and this was agreed to.

Board of Works Report. When the report of the Board of Works, which was a report on the good roads program, came up, Ald. Egidio moved an amendment that for curbing on Herkimer street, between James and Hess streets, there be substituted the repaving of Victoria avenue, from King Street to Hess street. Ald. Ten Eyck raised a vigorous objection to curbing being put down as local improvement, and the Board of Works, after a similar nature had been already paid for under the local improvement plan.

Ald. Hosen moved an amendment that curbing be done on James street south, striking out curbing on Baverstreet, from James to Westwood street.

Finally the report was passed to every one's satisfaction.

Sever Committee Report. The report of the Sewer Committee was passed with commendation.

In committee of the whole on bills, Ald. Massey in the chair, ex-Ald. Board, F. Chester Feanade and ex-Ald. Ross were present.

THE PROPOSED CONFERENCE

A Proposal to Make All the Book Concerns Contribute Exclusively to Superannuation Fund WAS TABLED BY A RISING VOTE

The Organic Law of the Church Came Up for Consideration—Committee on Episcopacy.

Chicago, May 14.—The General Conference of the Methodist Church today discussed the question of continuing the profits of the book concerns to the support of the superannuation fund. The question involved the withdrawing of subsidies from church publications that could not exist otherwise, and the payment of conference expenses.

The discussion was lengthy and at times spirited, but the matter was finally laid on the table by a rising vote.

Revision of Constitution. Discussion of the report of the Committee on the Revision of the Constitution and the report of the Committee on the Rules of the General Conference.

Just before adjournment Chairman Backler of the Committee on Episcopacy read the report bearing on the effectiveness of the Organic Law of the Church, which every bishop at present acting was recommended to be continued in the present relations.

Delegates for the Ecumenical. A motion by Bishop Hurst that a commission be created by the General Conference, consisting of one member from each General Conference district, to select the delegates to the Ecumenical Methodist Conference in London, was adopted.

Election of Bishops. The report of the Committee on the Election of Bishops, which was made public Saturday, recommending that the election of bishops be held under the present system, and resulted in a spirited debate.

The Choice of Editors. The section providing for the election of editors of the several Advances was recommended to the Board of Christian Literature, the intention being, it is understood, to continue the present system of publications, for which editors are to be selected.

Chairman Backler's Report. The time of the session was extended to May 15, and the report of the Board of Christian Literature was presented.

Erskine Church Pastorate. A meeting of the congregation of Erskine Presbyterian Church was held this evening to choose a successor to Rev. G. Shearer. The claims of seven candidates were considered, and the choice of the congregation fell on Rev. R. Martin of Markham. Mr. Martin preached in the church yesterday, and it is expected he will accept the call.
