An Act to repeal an Ordinance therein mentioned, intituled, "*An Ordinance for regulating the Markets of the Towns of Quebec and Montreal in the Province of Quebec.*"

WHEREAS it is right and necessary to repeal the Ordinance hereinafter mentioned ; Be it therefore enacted, &c., Preamble.

That a certain Ordinance made by the Captain General and Governor in Chief of the late Province of Quebec, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Province, in the seventeenth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "*An Ordinance for regulating the markets of the Towns of Quebec and Montreal, in the Province of Quebec,*" shall be and the same is hereby repealed. 17. Geo. III. c. 4. repealed.
