Is the United States Market Worth the Price that We Must Pay for it under Reciprocity?

A Question for Farmers From the Canadian Century. You lose your bet. During the fiscal year ending March 31, 1910, 227,954 pounds of cheese were imported into Canada from Switzerland.

Prices in the United States. Even if the Reciprocity Agreement did not let in Australia, New Zealand and the twelve foreign nations besides the United States, even if the favored nation treaties could be got rid of so that Canada could open its markets to the United States alone...

The Canadian farmer should compare the prices he obtains for his products in a small village near his farm, with the prices in Boston, New York, Chicago or some other large city in the United States.

A table of comparative prices in Montreal and Boston the week the Reciprocity Compact was made was compiled by The Mont real Herald, a Liberal newspaper, with the assistance of a number of prominent produce dealers and food experts.
