**HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY.**  
FREDERICTON, March 6.

Mr. Barker introduced a bill relating to the establishment, maintenance and management of Reformatory and Industrial Schools. Mr. Davidson is in the chair. The mover drew on the importance of the measure and the history of former efforts in St. John to secure the enactment of a measure of a similar kind. The present bill has a very careful consideration by the Sessions, and provides for the setting up of Reformatory, singly, or Reformatory and Industrial Schools together. Counties may erect buildings which are to be approved by the Lieutenant-Governor, and the institutions are to be under the control of five Directors, to be appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor. The Government is to contribute, by direction of the Legislature, a part of the funds necessary for the maintenance, but the burden of the maintenance is to fall on the County.
