LOCAL AND OTHER ITEMS

Mr. DANIEL MACDONALD of this city has been appointed night watchman for the Dominion building.

The residence of Bishop McMillan, at Hartford, Conn., was damaged by fire to the extent of \$40,000, on the afternoon of the 10th.

Hon. WILFRED LAUREN, leader of the Liberals in the House of Commons, is to address a public meeting in the Market Hall on Monday evening next.

WILHELM CHAMBERLAIN, leader of the Conservatives, was sleeping in his room on Thursday night, when he was smothered to death by the effects of which he died two hours afterwards.

CHAR. A. MOORE, of Digby, N. S., aged 33, passed a revolver to his head and shot himself dead, in the presence of his wife and children, early on Wednesday morning last. Excessive drinking is the only cause assigned.

The railway committee of the Privy Council have laid down the principle that in applications by municipalities to compel railway companies to protect level crossings, the applicants must pay half of the expense of protection desired.
