## PASTORAL LETTER.

DEAR FRIENDS,—

Under the guiding and sustaining hand of God we have been brought to the close of another ecclesiastical year, and the following report shows, as fully as figures can show, what has been done.

While to many of you it has been a year of sorrow and trial it has been to all a year crowned with divine goodness.

In connection with the Union Evangelistic Services held during the winter many professed conversion, especially among the scholars of the Sunday School. Many also from other Circuits connected themselves with the church so that there has been a substantial increase in membership.

The several funds of the church have been well sustained and it is very gratifying that the contributions to the 20th Century Thanksgiving Fund, including those from the Ladies' Aid Society, Sunday School and E. L. of C. E. amounted to \$1412.87. There is however need for a more general support of the Building Fund.

Your regular attendance upon the public services has been very cheering and I hope it will be continued, as far as possible, at both morning and evening service on the Lord's Day.

The valuable aid, financial and social, given by the Ladies' Aid Society and the very faithful and efficient services of the choir, have contributed in no small degree to the prosperity of the church.

The "Home Department" is a branch of our Sunday School work which I most heartily commend to your attention and hope all who cannot attend the school will avail themselves of its advantages.

Let both the E. L. of C. E. and the Sunday School have your heartiest co-operation for no church work pays better than that among children and young people.

Upon no consideration neglect family worship.

It is cause for regret that the immense amount of sickness during the winter together with the numerous special services so greatly interfered with systematic visiting.

In this growing community attention to strangers is a very important branch of our church work. Let it not be neglected.

## SUNDAY SCHOOL.



Annual Report of the McLeod Street Methodist Sunday School,  
for the Year Ending April 30th, 1900.

In presenting to you this Annual report, I do so believing that there is some reason for regret, and much reason for being encouraged and hopeful for the year upon which we are about to enter.

What has given the S. S. Board the most concern is the financial report, which shows an increase in expenditure and a decrease in revenue.

The additional expenditure is due largely to the outlay on our library and Home Department supplies. We believe that the decrease is due partly to the 20th Century Fund, and partly to the coppers finding their way to the gum boxes, and partly to the fact that the Superintendent has not urged for larger collections as much from the platform as he might have done.

Our average attendance has only dropped one for the year which we consider as favorable, when we bear in mind the numerous special meetings and attractions during the year.

The order and attention are decidedly improved, and we believe that better work has never been done than at the present time. The teachers are a most attentive band of workers, and the best of harmony prevails throughout.

Our library consists of about 650 volumes many of them small, but all in fairly good repair.

The Ladies are at work organizing the Home Department, Mrs. Shipman has been elected Superintendent and Mrs. A. D. Helmer, Secretary Treasurer. At a meeting recently held the workers present showed much interest in this new branch of work and reported having met with considerable success in their canvass. I am of opinion that the work of the S. S. will be kept immediately before the parents by means of this Department, and through the visitors I hope to have the wants and conditions of the school presented to the parents. We hope further, that an interest in the study of the Bible in the homes will be stimulated.

At the annual meeting of the S. S. Board it was decided in view of the financial stringency, to apply the Bible Class collection for the year to the reduction of our debt, and a committee was appointed to devise ways and means of increasing our revenue and report at the next meeting.
