when the principal floating debts of the Province were paid off, or rather, cen-solidated, Mr. Hincks had prepared the way for our becoming a respectable bor-rower, like other commonwealths, in the London market; and before two years are could point with some degrees of pride to a funded debt of between thirty and forty millions. That was what came of the glory of getting floating liabilities commuted into bonds at long dates twenty years ago. We have, it is true, a fair indirect re-turn for the borrowings of this period in our railways and the calargement of the canals. Bat we vesture to think that return would have been vastiy more satistactory had the facilities afforded the Minister for borrowing not been made quite so great as they were. Had the Grand Trutk, for instance, been started on a purely commercial basis, instead of being hurried through in a lump, as it was, without any sober regard to assured metars, it would have been infinitely better for the stockhelders, and a wonder-thal relief to the Provincial tax-pyer. It is too late now to remedy this or any part of it. But it is not to late to extract a lesson from the sequel to the story of consoridation twenky ocars ago. We are once again in the market, not as applicants for a miscrable discount to over official salaries, but as displied and reputable borrowers. And it is not out of place or out of time to consider whether these new facilities for getting into debt really illustrate any extraor-dinary thrift and skill, or whether they habits of profuse and uncalculating sx-penditure ; a dependence upon prospective, instead of actanal grains ; a reviral of mis-chievious views of what constitutes real and solid prosperity. It is welcomen news, of course, to know that the Domin-ion Government is no longer compelled, when its monthly bills come in, to deff its dignity in the bank manager's parlor, and sue for a five hundred discount liko a common forwarder. But it is as well to this twice over the matter when we are asked for a shout of joy, mere cause we have a chance temperarily of borrowing once again on a dignified scale. That is the sum of the schicvement, and nothing more as far as we are able to collimate it.




