FROM JAPAN AND CHINA.

Viscount Tanaka, Ex-Japanese Minister in France Permitted to wear a French Decoration.

The Revenue of the Tokyo Tramway Co. was \$17,384 during June, an Excess of \$4,098.

During June the Japanese post and telegraph revenue was \$568,337, a decrease of \$10,100 as compared with the previous month, and an increase of \$50,288 as compared with the corresponding period of last year.

It was announced that all the Government officials elected as members of Parliament, excepting Mr. Mutsu, Minister of Agriculture and Commerce, were about to resign their positions under Government.

In view of the ordeal through which the Japanese Budget has to go in Parliament, the greatest care is being exercised in its preparation. The main items tabled are to be taken up next week to the Finance officials of the various Departments.

The question of Government aid to the direct export of raw silk to America, has been under consideration in the Department of Agriculture and Commerce has decided to continue its assistance in order to continue Mr. Sonoda, President of the Yokohama Shikin Ginko, has offered to renew the financial arrangement with the Doshin Kaisha (Yokohama Raw Silk Co.) and has contracted with the company to grant a loan of \$1,000,000.

At the annual meeting of the shareholders of the Tokyo Stock Exchange a net profit of \$75,229 was reported. The net profit was \$76,082 by the sum of \$263 brought over from the last account. Of this it was decided to take \$1,000 to the reserve fund, disburse \$11,000 in remuneration and for expenses of officials, and to pay in dividend to the shareholders the sum of \$59 per share, being at the rate of 77 per cent. per annum; \$62 was carried over to next account.

FROM THE ORIENT.

Arrival of the City of Pekin from Hong Kong via the Pacific Line.

Yesterday afternoon the S. S. City of Pekin from the East arrived at the outer wharf with a full cargo of passengers. She only drew 24 feet, but her captain being new to the port he was unwilling to risk a full cargo of passengers to do so. According to the ship's log, which she had on board, she had to visit Victoria, in the year 1918, she sailed from Hong Kong on July 24th at 6 a. m. and arrived at Kobe July 25th at 5.37 p. m. She left that port July 29th at 10.25 a. m. and arrived at Victoria August 10th at 11.00 a. m. She had a smooth sea, and light winds, with dark foggy weather the entire trip.

The cabin passengers were Mrs. E. G. Davis, W. B. Hall and Mrs. S. Kahnweiler. She had on board 103 Chinese of whom 103 were for Victoria. The City of Pekin is an iron vessel of 5,070 tons and is a 423 feet long and is handily and well appointed in every particular.

Among her passengers were Rev. Bishop Newman, Bishop of the Methodist Episcopal church of the United States who had been to that country attending the session of the Japanese conference. There were upon the conference list about fifty missionaries, while including male and female teachers, English speaking and foreign, there were about 85. They were establishing schools at Tokio, towards which he (Dr. Newman) had given \$5,000. Dr. Newman spoke of the increasing success of Christian and educational efforts, but noted with regret that only half the school population were being educated. The system prevailing was too rigorous and exacting, and had begun at the top instead of at the bottom. In New England and the rest of the American states educational effort had begun with the elements of reading and writing but in Japan they had commenced at the top with almost equal care to the university education. The feeling which prevailed was hopeful, although there was some uneasiness of progress in the European methods. Already they had made great advancement, and in a few years it would be possible to meet great strides in that direction. He noted great improvements in Japan since his visit there seven years ago, the country was more fully open to civilization. He regarded the political revolution which had taken place as one of leaders rather than of principle, although the ideas upon which it had taken place were those of progress.

Rev. D. V. McArthur, Methodist missionary at Tokio, who has been three years in the country, was also among the passengers. He was returning with his wife who had a severe affection of the eyes, from which strangers were apt to suffer. The Japanese mission field was an exceedingly hopeful one, and it was much to his regret that he had been compelled to temporarily leave it. He spoke of the city of Tokio as being very beautiful, many of the buildings being very fine and modern architecture.
