THE SECRETARY-GENERAL Immunity from Taxation

a. All property, both real and personal, including all assets, funds contributions to the Appeal, monetary or non-monetary, made under the draft agreement and belonging to the National Council and all movement storage, custody and disposals of said property in accordance with the said draw agreement shall be immune from taxes, fees, tolls, or duties imposed by Parliament of Canada.

Custody of Contributions

a. The National Council shall place all monetary contributions in special accounts under its name. These special accounts shall be maintained in deposiories selected by the National Council in consultation with the Government of anada. Funds shall be withdrawn or transferred from these special accounts in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

b. The National Council shall safeguard and conserve all non-monetary ontributions by taking all needful action, including insuring, storing and transorting such non-monetary contributions. In the case of supplies or other assets hose kind or condition requires early distribution, the National Council shall onsult immediately with the Secretary-General to ensure their immediate dishoution and, as far as possible, the implementation of Article VI of this

C. The National Council shall indemnify and hold the United Nations and Secretary-General and their or his employees and agents harmless from any arising out of the operations of the National Council under this Agreement. The National Council shall take out adequate insurance according to the laws Canada or other similar protection against the risks referred to in this b-paragraph.
