CANADIAN INDUSTRIAL ARTS INSTRUCTORS TO VEST INDIES

THE SERVICES OF TWO INDUSTRIAL ARTS INSTRUCTORS FROM ONTARIO ARE BEING MADE AVAILABLE TO THE WEST INDIES UNDER THE CANADA-WEST INDIES AID PROGRAMME. THE TWO INSTRUCTORS ARE MR. EDGAR H. RICE OF GALT AND MR. EDBERT FURGER OF PEMBROKE.

AS WELL AS STRVING AS INSTRUCTORS, MR. FUDGER AND ME.

RICE WILL ALSO SUPERVISE THE INSTALLATION OF MACHINE SHOP

AND WOOD-WORKING EQUIPMENT TO BE SUPPLIED BY CANADA TO THE

TECHINICAL EDUCATION CENTRE IN ST. KIT'S AS PART OF THE

CAPITAL AID PROGRAMME.

THE ONTARIO TRAINING COLLEGE FOR TECHNICAL TEACHERS AND AT THE ONTARIO COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, MR. RICE HAS SERVED FOR MANY YEARS AS DIRECTOR OF SHOPS FOR THE GALT BOARD OF EDUCATION, TEACHING WOODWORKING AND ALLIED DRAFTING. WE IS A MEMBER OF THE ONTARIO EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, THE ONTARIO VOCATIONAL TRUCATION ASSOCIATION AND THE INDUSTRIAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE GALT BOARD OF TRADE, AND A FORMER MEMBER OF THE TECHNICAL RESEARCH COUNCIL. MR. RICE HAS WRITE A BOOK ON CARPENTRY AND GENERAL WOODWORKING WHICH WAS PUBLICATED WITH FEDERAL CO-OPERATION BY THE ONTARIO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND IS BEING USED IN CORRESPONDENCE COURSES IN ALL TENPROVINCES.

MR. FUDGER HAS BEEN GRANTED LEAVE OF ABSENCE FIRM THE CAMP PETAWAWA DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE TEACHES: MICHINE SHOP PRACTICE AND WELDING. HE TAUGHT FOR MANY YEARS AT VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS IN KINGSTON AND SERVED IN THE CANADIAN ARMY (MILITIA) FROM 1942 ATTAINING THE RANK OF CAPTAIN.

HR. FUDGER IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS FEDERATION.

THE TWO VOCATIONAL INSTRUCTORS ARRIVED IN ST. KITTS ON JAK-UARY 3. THEY EXPECT TO REMAIN IN THE WEST INDIES FOR APPROX-IMATELY ONE YEAR.
