The French Clergy—Announcement. In the great political movement which is now being agitated throughout the length and breadth of this extensive Province, no man has been left unemployed by the opponents of Annexation to defeat its successful accomplishment.

It is that which appeals to the religious and patriotic feelings of the people, and which subjects its motives and objects to the wisdom and intelligence of the people at large, the cause of Annexation has nothing to fear. The plain and unvarnished facts which are submitted by its advocates—the great necessity which, at the present moment, requires its interposition, and the innumerable advantages enjoyed by that favored confederacy with which it seeks an alliance, are circumstances which can no longer be disregarded by the Canadian people.

CANADIAN AFFAIRS.
