Special Evening Telegram. ATHENS, June 5. Another conflict has occurred between the Greeks and the Turks, near Dereli, in Grecian territory. Five Turks were killed.

GETTINGE, Montenegro, June 5. The Miridits, the most powerful of the Albanian tribes, have revolted against the Turks, and have proclaimed autonomy for Albania.

LONDON, June 5. The libel suit of Inspector Dew, of Scotland Yard, against the Montreal Star, for the publication of statements in connection with the Crippen case, has been settled.

DUBLIN, June 5. John Dillon, the Nationalist, has been dangerously injured in an automobile accident near Dundalk.

criticizes Lord Selborne's attacks on the Canadian-United States Reciprocity agreement, asserting that he is entirely wrong in his statements, and quoting Trade returns to prove that British Trade is not seriously menaced by the agreement.

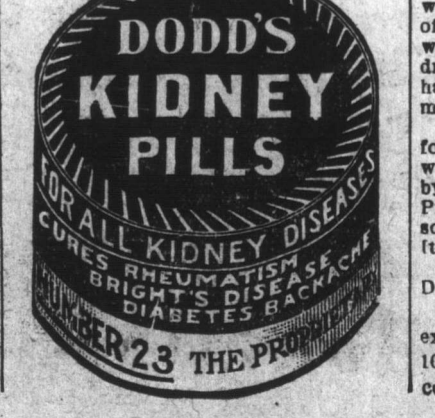

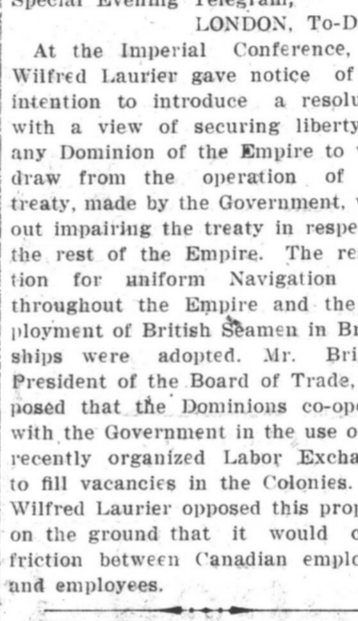
