Kingstown, St. Vincent, March 22. - The eruption of La Soufriere, which began yesterday, continued and increased in activity during the night. It became most violent at 7 o'clock this morning. At half past 8 o'clock this morning the violence was unabated, and the spectacle was awe inspiring. The crater is belching forth dense black clouds, which rise heavenwards, accompanied by loud roars and flashes, which reach the great pall of smoke, which now envelopes the entire island in darkness. Electrical discharges occurred at intervals during the night, while at daybreak the sunlight playing on the stupendous volcanic clouds produced beautiful effects.
