FOR YEAR 1892.

During the past year the work has been quietly and steadily continued. Funds for carrying it on have been wonderfully provided, God having touched the hearts of many kind friends to help Miss Latimer, the true and faithful Bible-Woman; and could they only follow her in her visits to the poor, the sick, the helpless, and see the joy she leaves behind her, they would feel amply repaid; and not only does she help their bodily distress, but she carries to them God's Own Word, which alone can give comfort to a sin-sick soul.

During the year, Miss Latimer collected \$155.50 for buying provisions and wood to distribute to the needy during the winter, for which her hearty thanks are returned to the subscribers.

A few words from Miss Latimer's monthly report may be interesting.

Tuesday.—"Visited four families who were sick. Took bread and beef to ten families. Saw Mrs. W—, the woman who sent for me, she was sick in bed—got the woman who lives over her to make beef tea for her, and then I went to get help."

Wednesday.—"Visited eight families in the suburbs, found Mrs. M——, in great trouble. Sent things to eight families—found Mrs. I.——able to walk a little."

The Mothers' Meetings are held every Friday afternoon, from December until May, in one of the rooms of the Jeffery Hale Sunday School. The ladies who took charge were Mrs. Dean, Mrs. Mussen, Mrs. Shaw, Mrs. Bonham, Mrs. Gale and Miss Pope. The material given to the women is sold to them at half price. During the afternoon a Bible Lesson is given by one of the Committee, and while sewing is going on, a book is read. Thanks are due to Mrs. Ross for a piece of flannel for the meetings, and also to Miss Ross for kindly providing a tea for the women once a month.

The ('ommittee have experienced a great loss in the death of their Secretary, Miss Hossack, who acted efficiently for over ten years, and
