



Any person who is the sole head

in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his home-stead. Price \$2.00 per acre. Duties— Must ragide upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six

pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry, (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted tis homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$2.00 per acre. Dutles—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
