SECOND EDITION. PREMIER ABBOTT. HON. J. J. C. ABBOTT TO FORM A Cabinet.

THIS is Confirmed With Lord Stanley's Decision—The Cabinet Support of His Colleagues is Assured to Him. BY TELEGRAPH TO THE GAZETTE.

Ottawa, June 18.—The GAZETTE correspondent writes as follows:—I have been ordinarily furnished with the following: We understand that in conforming with His Excellency's wish, Mr. J. J. C. Abbott, has undertaken the formation of a Cabinet and that the decision has been arrived at with full understanding with those of his colleagues who have been spoken of in connection with the possibility of being members of the cabinet.

The Liberals are jubilant over the situation as they see from their point of view every possibility of an early split in the ranks. Mr. Chapsal declared to your correspondent that Thompson was the only man available under the circumstances.

Ottawa, June 18.—The announcement that Mr. Abbott had been called upon to form a cabinet was eagerly discussed at every street corner and in the clubs and hotels. Nearly the government supporters are absent, but those who were directly in opposition to the wisdom of the Governor General's choice.

Sir John Thompson, it is stated, had the return of the premiership. All his Quebec supporters do not regard him as Mr. Abbott's rival, and if they persist in this course, great events will occur during the coming week.

Ottawa, June 18.—An accident to the freight train between Montreal and Quebec occurred near Wicksford Junction this morning. It was caused by the breaking of an axle of the engine. The train was badly torn up, the ties for about 1000 feet ripped and torn into splinters, the cars were scattered all over the track. There was no loss of life. The damage to the rolling stock and freight is heavy. The road will probably be blocked all day.

THE CONVENTION WITH PORTUGAL. BY TELEGRAPH TO THE GAZETTE.

Lisbon, June 18.—The convention with Portugal provides that goods in transit through Portuguese territory between the West Coast and British ports shall not for a period of 25 years be subjected to a duty above 3 per cent. It also provides that the goods in transit shall be exempt from all duties on payment of a sum equal to the amount of the duty on the goods.
