REPORT

OF THE

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY

FOR THE YEAR 1879.

The Committee of Management have the honor topresent the 44th annual report.

The revenue which the Society has received from its investments has not been as large as in previous years owing to the continued depression in commercial matters, still your Committee have endeavoured as far as possible to relieve all deserving cases that have been brought under their notice. Aid has been extended to one hundred and nineteen cases, comprising one hundred and fifty seven persons. The total amount expended in charity is \$563 87, details of which will be found in the report of the Sub-Committee of Charity.

The Treasurer's Report conveys full information as to our financial position. The sum of \$2,700, 6 per cent. Dominion Stock having been redeemed by Government on 1st December the proceeds have been invested in 42 shares of the Banque du Peuple, and 11 shares of the Bank of Toronto.

During the year, three ordinary members have been elected, and one has resigned.

The usual anniversary service was held in the Cathedral on the evening of St. Georges' Day when an excellent

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sermon was preached by Rev. M. M. Fothergill, one of the Chaplain's to the Society, Rev. G. V. Housman and Rev. C. W. Rawson assisting in the service. The musical portion of the service was kindly undertaken by E. A. Bishop Esq., Organist of the Cathedral, assisted by the Ladies and Gentlemen of the choir and others, to all of whom the thanks of the Society are specially due for their very valuable services. The collection in aid of the Society's charitable fund amounted to \$77 07.

We have to mourn the loss by death of Messrs Samuel Pope a life member and for a long period chairman of charitable committee, Charles Gates Holt a life member since 1851 and Robert Lomas an ordinary member.

A subject which occupied the attention of the Society was a proposal made by a member that in order to secure to the society the benefit of the experience of gentlemen who have occupied the Presidents' chair all Past-Presidents should in future be ex-officio members of the Committee of management. This proposition was referred by the Committee to James Dunbar Esq., Q. C., for his legal opinion and he reported that such action would be contrary to the Constitution of the Society but that the same object might be attained by electing Past-Presidents as regular members of the Committee. Mr. Dunbar also generously donated his fee to the Society and it was applied to charitable objects.

For further information in regard to the Society's affairs, members are referred to the report of the sub-committee of charity.

William Patton, born at Low Leyton, Essex England, 26th July, 1789

5th April, 1853. Admiral Edward Boxer, C. B., Born at Pover, Ken. Died at Balaklava 4th June, 1855.

Peter Sheppard, native of Guernsey, came to Canada in 1809. Died at Quebec, 23rd Augus', 1856, at the age of 63 years;

John Racey Senior, native of Bath, came to Quebec in 1801. Died in

England in 1-56 at the age of 73 years.

The Earl of Ellesmere, K. G., visited the United States, in 1854, as one of the Queen's Commissioners to attend the opening of the New York.

Crystal Palace, which made him favorably known to the American people. He wi ited Quebec also at that time, and was the guess of seal and of Eigin. He expired at Bridgewater house, St. James, on Wed-He vi ited Quebec also at that time, and was the guest of the nesday, the 18th March, 1857. The deceased was born on the first January, 1800.

The Right Revd. George Jehosaphat Mountain, D.D., D.C.L., Lord Bishop of Quebec, was the second son of dishop Jacob Mountain, the first Anglican bishop of Queber. He was born 27th July, 1789, at Norwich, England, came to Canada with his father, 1703, and died after a brief illness at Bardfield, his country seat, on 5th lany, 1863. He was nineteen years Rector of Quibec, and was consecrated Bishop 14th February, 1836. He was a diligent visitor among his flock, and in the dreadful visitations of cholera in 1832 and 1834, he literally lived night and day among the dying and the dead, while in 1847, when the prevince was visit d with the plague of typhus fever, and the poor emigrants were dying by thousands at the Quarantine station, the Bishop took his turn at Gross. Isle regularly with the rest of the clergy; and again when the cho'era visited Quebec, 1849 and 1854 he was diligent in visiting the hospitals. During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his Life membership, contributed regularly to the Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times took a great interest in its proceedings.


