OUR BIRD BIRDS

Lecture by Mr. Montague Chamberlain in the Church Hall.

A fair attendance greeted the third lecture of the Women's Aid Course held in the Church hall on Tuesday evening. His theme, "Our Song Birds" was not a very expansive one, but lovers of natural history found it quite an interesting one nevertheless. Mr. Chamberlain said we had 200 species of birds in New Brunswick, and of these about 100 were singers, part were resident and part migratory, the latter being the majority. Investigation of the subject had discovered that areas of similar birds were determined by the temperature, altitude and fauna, the fauna following the nature of the geological formation; and, in this respect, he said the gap he had on exhibition to illustrate the scientific explorations as regards bird song, had, though prepared by himself, a striking resemblance to the geological map of North America outlined by Prof. Bailey. Distance or proximity had very little relation to the species of birds that prevailed in localities as compared with each other; for instance, a number of species were found in this province that were never found in Bangor.

Our singers were even more numerous than those of England. We have 40 species to England's 25. Four were generally songsters, although we had nothing to equal the English skylark or the mocking bird of the southern states. Our birds were divided into three general classes, namely: finches, warblers and thrushes, of which the latter four forth the richest melody. The result of observation was to show that birds sing only in their home. Happening to be in Fredericton one fine summer morning, the lecturer said that while taking a leisurely walk with his wife he found no less than 40 different species of birds in the Celestial City.

The champion nest-builder of them all was the chickadee. Birds migrated in the night, was evidenced by the myriads that dashed themselves to death against the lighted windows on the coast and the electric lights of the great cities in the neighboring republics—some of them being of the most brilliant plumage. In referring to the gaudy wrangler that flitted through tropical forests like sparks of the parent gem, Mr. Chamberlain closed with a scintillating reference to the women of fashion, at whose shrines more than one hundred millions of innocent beauties are sacrificed annually. The forgetfulness of the singer and shirter these ladies bent to this insidious slaughter often placed them in ridiculous positions. A notable case in point having occurred to his own personal knowledge, where a young lady in attempting to reprimand a boy for robbing nests of birds eggs was promptly rebuffed by the youth that he never helped to kill the creatures that laid them so that he might trim his hair like hers. As a whole, the lecture showed considerable ability, and at its conclusion, on motion of Rev. Rector Roberts, a vote of thanks was given to Mr. Chamberlain.

Temperance Work in England.

To the Editor of the Globe:—In addition to the facts concerning temperance progress in England so admirably set forth by Sir Leonard Tilley at the Church Hall on Monday night the following figures may give the most recent. The Metropolitan and other news of extent of temperance progress in England.

The Church of England has 7,500 juvenile total abstinence societies, with 567,000 members. The Wesleyans, 1,501 societies, and 292,000 members. There are 703 Jesuitical temples, with 50,000, and an upper class Union of eighty-four branches and 9,000. In all it is reckoned that there are 1,500,000 temperance societies, with 1,524,500 young recruits for the temperance cause.

Joining the Foresters' Rank.

The Independent Order of Foresters appear to be gaining as great a hold upon the people here as in any part of Ontario. Court St. Barry held a special meeting for initiation alone, on Tuesday night last, and ten new members joined the order. The regular monthly meeting will be held on Tuesday evening next when it is expected that some ten or twelve other men will seek admission into the court. The principles of this benevolent society when properly presented commend themselves to everyone rich and poor alike, and when a man once becomes a Forester and learns of the little workings of the order and the advantages to be derived from it, he never turns his back upon the order but on the contrary becomes greatly attached to it.

A Notice to Ministers.

The attention of ministers is called to section eight of chapter 71 of the consolidated statutes, page 981, requiring them to transmit all certificates of marriage solemnized by them to the Clerk of the Peace of the county in which the marriage is solemnized, for registration.

THREE LICENSES.

Some Lively Bidding at the Crown Land Office Yesterday.

There was a large crowd of lumbermen present at the sale of timber lands at the crown land office yesterday and some lively bidding ensued. Every berth was completed and went for in advance of the upset price. Lot No. 22, head of Shillshew river, and also lot 37 in the same range, 40 miles in all went to the applicant, Mr. Michael Welch, but he was required to pay \$50 in advance of the upset price, or \$30 per square mile, owing to the keen competition. The lots were knocked down to Mr. Thor. Bohan for \$16 per square mile, the applicant being Mr. E. H. Haddock. The next lot, No. 23, on the head of Rockwell stream, Sunbury county, where it is said the lands are about the same as valueless, was captured by the applicant Mr. E. H. Mitchell, for \$30 in advance of upset price, or \$53 per square mile. There was a large number of Sunbury county men present, and the bidding was very brisk on the land. Lot No. 55, New Cassan river, 2 miles, applied for by Mr. Patrick McPherson, was bid in by Thomas Bathurst, for \$11 in advance of upset price.

The Metropolitan's Speech.

To the Editor of THE GLOBE:—

Sir:—The effusion of a verdant striping which appears in the Farmer, seeking to dispute the accuracy of the report made by your reporter on the address of the Metropolitan on Monday evening on the temperance question, betrays as much ignorance as presumption. The whole of THE GLOBE's report of the proceedings of the meeting in the Church Hall bears truth on the very face of it. Why did Rector Roberts, Mr. Alexander and Sir Leonard Tilley find it necessary to express so emphatically—though they did so in a most friendly and courteous manner—their dissent from His Lordship's views? His Lordship himself in the last man who would seek to accuse your reporter of misrepresentation, for His Lordship's view on the temperance question are well known, nor has he ever sought to disguise them. They followed a set-to between Jim Gibbons and Dave Stockford, which was witnessed with a good deal of interest. Dave showing his skill in the art to a very good advantage in fact, the professional. After this contest a large number of sets followed between several of the Finemore and young Williams. They fought under the cheers of the audience for the most part, but the contest between the two was a draw. The entertainment closed in a wind up, a six round glove contest between the Gibbons brothers, which was pronounced to be the finest exhibition of sparring that has been witnessed in the city for a long time. The Gibbons brothers leave for New Jersey on Saturday next.

The Northern Lawn Tennis Association.

England has decided to commemorate the Queen's Jubilee next June, the occasion being the 50th anniversary of Victoria's accession to the throne, by a tennis tournament. The first prize will be \$250, and 32 of the best tennis players will be invited to compete for it. The second prize will be \$125, and 16 players will be invited to contest this class.

A Preliminary Meeting has been held at Sydney, N. S. W., with a view of promoting a big collecting handicapped sweepstakes on the Paramatta river, open to the world, at the latter end of 1887.

Black Birch.

The price of black birch of best quality has recently gone up from \$7 to \$85 per 1,000. The extraordinary advance is due to the discovery that boards cut out of the first logs are susceptible of a very high price, and can be used for almost any purpose hitherto exclusively reserved for mahogany, which is worth \$200 a thousand. The advance has been expedited by the discovery that the best black walnut is giving out. Black walnut from Arkansas and the south is so porous that it is of very little use in furniture making. The best black birch is found almost exclusively on the barren copper ore regions between Milwaukee and Ashland, where all other timber is stunted in growth and very poor. Here boards out of the butt cut quickly assume a beautiful red tint on being exposed to the atmosphere, and can be polished up to a great degree of fineness. The price will soon fall to \$30 or \$40 a thousand, as a railroad is being laid right through the very inaccessible region where it grows, and the high prices have tempted several men to open out new mills. Red beech has also advanced in price very rapidly. It could be bought up recently in Indiana and Ohio for the bare cost of sawing, but now it is worth \$30 a thousand.—Lumberman's Gazette.

THE CHRISTMAS KITCHEN.

Preparations for Santa Claus—Plum Pudding Recipes "Get it done, Omelette."

As Christmas puddings are usually made and baked a few days before they are required for table, when the pudding is taken out of the pot, hang it up immediately, and put a plate underneath it. The day it is to be eaten, plunge it into boiling water, and keep it boiling for a couple of hours.

RECIPE FOR NO. 1.

Half a pound of raisins, 1 lb. of currants, 1 lb. of mixed peel, 1 lb. of bread crumbs, 1 lb. of sugar, 8 eggs, 1 wineglassful of brandy, (for those who object to brandy, a little milk). Stone and cut the raisins in halves, but do not chop them; wash, pick, and dry the currants, and mince the best fruit; cut the candied peel into thin slices, and grate down the bread into fine crumbs. Mix well together, and add the well beaten eggs. Stir well, that everything may be very thoroughly blended, and press the pudding into a buttered mould; tie it down tightly with a floured cloth, and boil five or six hours. It may be boiled in a cloth without a mould, and will require the same time for cooking.

NO. 2.

One pound of suet, 1 lb. of currants, 1 lb. of mixed raisins, 8 eggs, 1 grated nutmeg, 2 oz. of sliced candied peel, 1 teaspoonful of ground ginger, 1 lb. of bread crumbs, 1 lb. of flour, 1 pt. of milk. Mix as before and boil for 5 hours or rather longer.

NO. 3.

Half a pound of mixed crumbs, 1 lb. beef suet, 1 lb. flour, 1 lb. sugar, 1 lb. raisins, 1 lb. currants, one teaspoonful powdered cinnamon, one teaspoonful powdered ginger, 1 lb. citrons, 1 gill milk, 4 eggs, 1 teaspoonful baking-powder, 1 of a nutmeg. Mix as before, and boil for 4 hours either in a buttered mould or cloth.

NO. 4. WITHOUT ROSE.

Half a pound of flour, 6 oz. raisins, 6 oz. currants, 1 lb. chopped suet, 1 lb. brown sugar, 1 lb. mashed carrots, 1 lb. potatoes, 1 lb. molasses, 1 lb. candied lemon-peel, 1 oz. candied citron. No liquid is to be put into the mixture, and the ingredients are better to be mixed over night. Tie it loosely in a cloth, or if put in a basin, do not quite fill it, as the pudding should have room to swell, and boil it 4 hours.

Plum Pudding Recipes.

Hand Suet.—1 lb. suet, 1 lb. butter, 1 lb. of a nutmeg, white of one egg. Put the butter and sugar together in a bowl, and beat them to a cream, adding suet as it is required. Do not stir, which may be prevented by keeping it cool. Whip the white of egg to a stiff froth, and mix this lightly into the cream. When this is done put the mass into a crystal dish for serving, and grate over it the nutmeg.

FRUIT Suet.—Beat to a cream a cupful of sugar, and half a cupful of butter, add one teaspoonful of vanilla, or two of rose water, and two tablespoonfuls of fruit juice, and disolved currant jelly. Just before it is sent to the table stir into it 1-4 cup of boiling water, and white of an egg beaten to a stiff froth. This sauce may be served in a deep bowl that is standing hot water, and if not served in the same, should be poured into a heated sauce-boat.

Whipped cream with little sugar in it, and a flavoring of lemon, vanilla or rose-water, make a good sauce for plum-pudding.

One and a half pound of butter, 1 lb. sugar, 4 eggs, 1 gill cream, 5 lbs. flour, 8 lbs. raisins, 1 lb. currants, 1 lb. citrons, 1 nutmeg, 1 lb. candied lemon-peel, 1 lb. candied citron, 1 lb. candied orange-peel, 1 lb. candied apple-peel, 1 lb. candied quince-peel, 1 lb. candied pineapple-peel, 1 lb. candied fig-peel, 1 lb. candied raisins, 1 lb. candied almonds, 1 lb. candied hazelnuts, 1 lb. candied walnuts, 1 lb. candied chestnuts, 1 lb. candied pineapples, 1 lb. candied melons, 1 lb. candied peaches, 1 lb. candied apricots, 1 lb. candied cherries, 1 lb. candied plums, 1 lb. candied
