Opposed by Church Bodies. Dr. Gilmour, M.L.A., introduced the deputation to the Premier, and Mr. J. A. Peterson acted as chairman.

The secretary of the committee of the Methodist Church and of the joint committee recently formed to fight the bill, Dr. Sturgeon Stewart, said that during the past few days protests against proposed legislation from Peterboro, London, Lindsay, Brantford, Hamilton, Cambridge, St. Thomas, Oshawa, Ayr, Woodstock, Cambridge, and over 40 other outside points, principal boards of education, trust boards. From an amount of \$100,000,000, the rate was about 15 mills; whereas in this city the rate would be about 14 1/2 mills, or a reduction of one-half mill, or 50 cents on every \$100 of valuation.

Er. Al. William Hall, in support of the bill, said he was sorry to hear reference made to apostates. BRITISH REVERSES IN ASSAM.

MASSACRE OF A DETACHED PARTY OF INFANTRY AND OFFICERS.

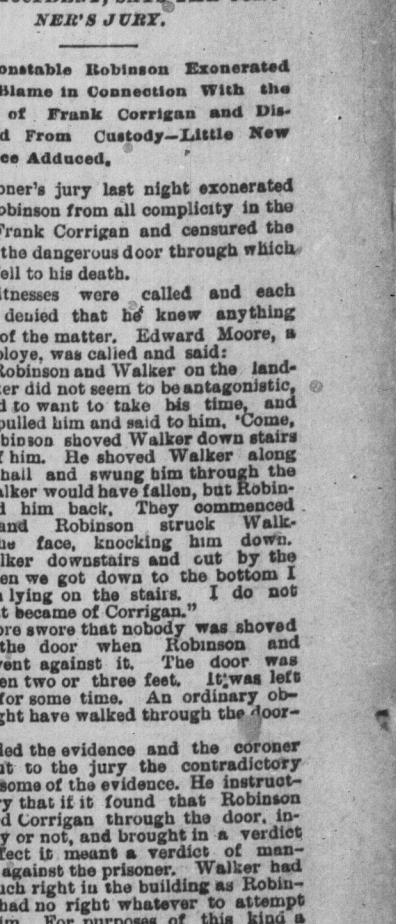

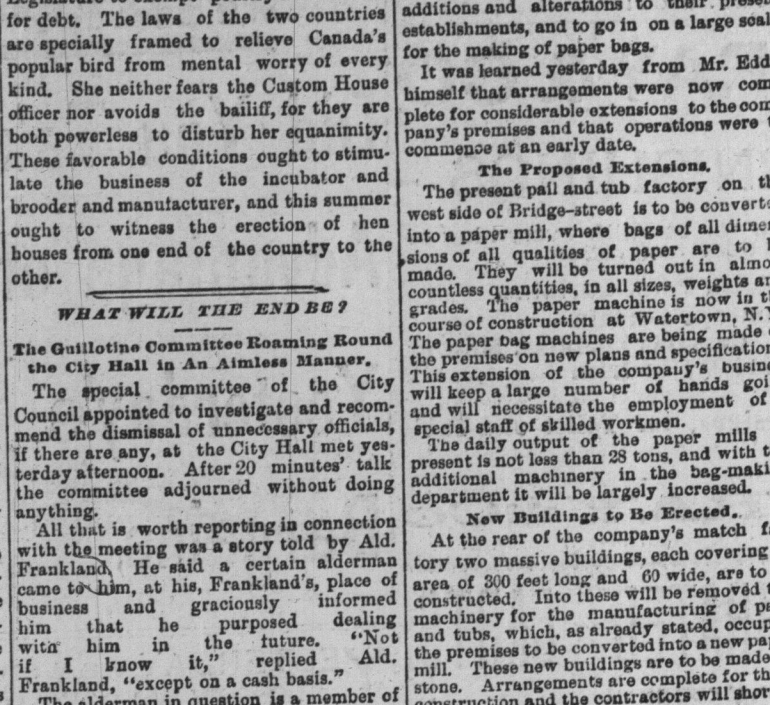
