PREFACE.

The rising generation is the hope of the Church. To assist the youthful mind, therefore, in obtaining an early acquaintance with the sacred truths of the Gospel, and particularly with the life, character and precepts of the Saviour and his apostles, is an object worthy the attention of all, and especially of those who have the charge of immortal souls. Deeply impressed with this truth, the Author of this catechism has noticed with much satisfaction, the increased attention, which has of late years been paid by Ministers of the Gospel, and instructors of youth, parents and heads of families, to the early pious instruction of the children. And especially, has he beheld, with peculiar pleasure, the rapid multiplication of Sabbath Schools, which he conceives to be peculiarly adapted to the accomplishment of this most important object; and promises, not only to be highly useful to the rising generation, but a distinguished blessing to the Christian Church.

The first object of Sabbath Schools, (especially where literature is not particularly attended to,) is to enrich the minds of youth with a knowledge of the Holy Scriptures, and to impress their momentous truths upon the heart and conscience. To effect this, one of the exercises in these Schools, generally has been, for the children to learn to repeat lengthy passages of Scripture, and even whole chapters, ver-

batum. But, this exercise, which, in every point of view, is highly useful and important, requires too great a stretch of memory for the capacities of children in general. The consequence of which is very injurious: for this study, which should, above all others, be pursued with pleasure, soon becomes an irksome task. And it is from a strong desire to remedy this evil, that the Author has been induced to form the subsequent catechism, which is designed to assist the young, in committing to memory the interesting historical facts, and important doctrinal and practical truths of the Gospel, and to impress them more forcibly upon the mind.

It will be perceived from the first view of this Catechism, that it is not intended for any particular class of Children, or sect of Christians; but is equally calculated for children of all descriptions, and of all denominations: as the questions are generally asked, and the answers always to be given, in the language of Scripture: and that, not by selecting some detached passages, but by taking the whole text in a connected chain of questions and answers.

That the child may never be at a loss to find the answer to any question, the verse or verses in which it is contained, are referred to at the end of the question. Where two verses are referred to for the answer, the figures are separated by a comma; and where more than two, the first and last only are put down, and a dash (—) substituted for the intermediate verses.
