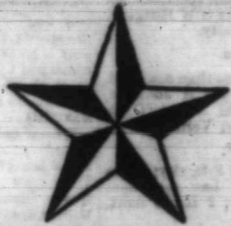

Nancy Hanks has added another jewel to her crown as queen of the turf. In the presence of 10,000 people, at Turf Haute, Ind., last Wednesday afternoon, she covered the mile on a regulation track in 2:04 flat. The third quarter was made in 29 1/2 seconds. This is the first time that a quarter has ever been covered by either a trotter or pacer in less than thirty seconds, and she finished strong. This breaks all records and leaves a long arduous question of whether the mile track is faster than the regulation one still unanswered.

Budd Doble expressed himself as confident that he can trot under two minutes, provided all the conditions are favorable to fast time. Her best previous time, as every horse lover knows, was made at the recent Independence meeting, where she traversed the mile track in 2:05 1/2. Her record on the regulation track up to Wednesday was 2:07 flat, made at St. Paul. What her limit of speed is none can tell. Another excellent feature of the afternoon's sport was the breaking by Mombars of Astelle's long-standing three-year-old record of 2:12. He was driven out in 2:11 1/2. There was no variance in time, and once more the regulation track holds the record. Budd Doble sent a message to Robert Bonner advising him of Nancy Hanks' achievements, and the owner of the St. Paul and had offered \$5,000 for the first trotter that beats 2:00.
