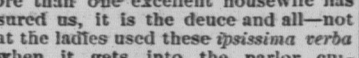

[To the Associated Press.] New York, Oct. 12—P. m. Brig Achertse, of P. E. Island, from Pictou for Pembroke with coal, went ashore Saturday on Kaim Island, near Seaport. She is full of water and will break up.

The Government of Spain presented a long note to the French Government in regard to immunity from interference enjoyed by the Carlists in receipt of supplies and munitions of war across the border and other violations of frontier by Royalists. It seems the French Government required specific charges from Spain and this note is a reply to that demand.

A CARLIST DEFEAT. The Republican army defeated 3,000 Carlists, with heavy loss, at Artoja de Navarre, Spain, on the 11th inst.

THE ARGENTINE INSURRECTION. Gen. Mitre has issued a manifesto, announcing that he has assumed command of the insurgent force in the Argentine States.

COUNT VON ARMIN'S trial will take place soon, and his case will be disposed of before the opening of the German Parliament.

THE FRENCH ELECTIONS. The result of the election for Councils General in France is the election of 672 Republicans, 604 Monarchists and 153 Bonapartists.
