Let Thy wisdom be her guide, and let Thine arm strengthen her ; let justice, truth and holiness, let peace and love, and all those virtues that adorn the Christian Profession flourish in her days ; direct all her counsels and endeavors to Thy glory and the welfare of her people ; and give us grace to obey her cheerfully and willingly for conscience' sake, that neither our sinful passions, nor our private interests, may disappoint her cares for the publick good ; let her always possess the hearts of her people, that they may never be wanting in honor to her Person, and dutiful submission to her Authority ; let her Reign be long and prosperous and crown her with immortality in the life to come ; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
