The Toilet Table.

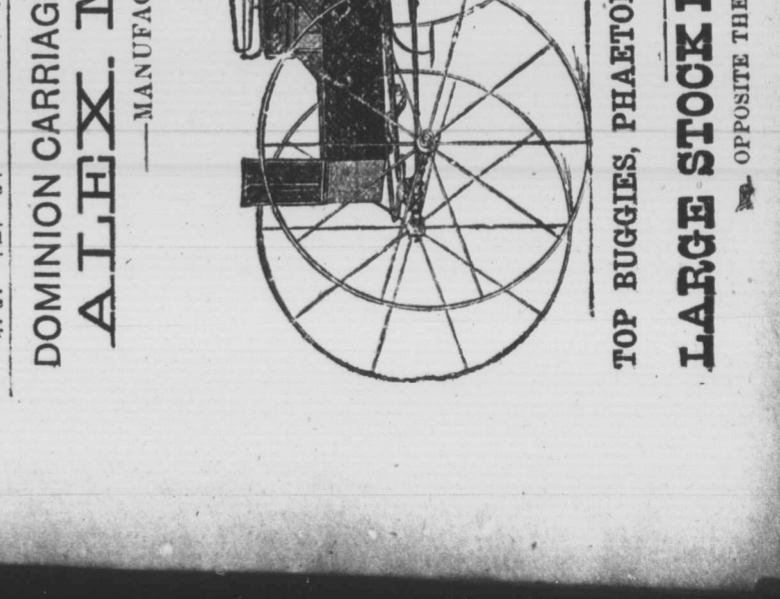
