We do not wish to under-rate what Quebec and Nova Scotia and New Brunswick say. They are paying more now than they did five years ago, due to the fact that the N. P. has added to their business and their means of payment. Nor will we dispute the fact that Manitoba is beginning to pay herself. But it is a tremendous mistake to suppose that the N. P. makes manufacturers dearer in Manitoba.

The World supports protection on these two grounds mainly: First, that it is necessary to make the country a nation—to make it a whole country, a self-sustaining one, to the extent possible. It advocates the industrial, manufacturing independence which is progressing in Canada today, as the material basis of the political independence which it is to be.

Again, why does not the Free Press see that upholding the N. P. is the only chance for developing manufactures in Manitoba itself? Suppose there were no N. P., would the Waterloo company of Bramford have a branch manufacturing establishment in Winnipeg? We say no, most decidedly no.

### An Expert Shot

Ellsworth Bisschop is remarkably skillful with a rifle. One of his latest shots is described as follows: A piece of half-inch gas pipe was inserted through a heavy piece of iron as a base. At one end of the pipe he affixed the blade of a hatchet, so that the sharp edge rested against the pipe. On either side of the hatchet he hung a glass ball. Standing off at a distance of forty feet, he fired with a Winchester repeating rifle at the exposed end of the gas-pipe, through which the bullet passed and was split on the hatchet edge, each half breaking the glass ball on either side of the hatchet. Having done this remarkable shot to his satisfaction in the ordinary manner, he tried it in a different manner. Holding the gun over his shoulder, he sighted through a small mirror he held in his left hand, and fired with his back to the object. Again did the ball pass through the gas-pipe, split on the hatchet edge and break both balls. Still another way was tried. Bending over, he held the rifle down and sighted under his leg, again making the shot successfully.
