THIRTEENTH YEAR CANAL REBATES ABOLISHED.

Official Announcement by the Premier That Existing System Will be Terminated at the End of the Present Season—A Conference Between the Two Governments Suggested.

MONTREAL, Aug. 14.—The fact that Montreal was temporarily the seat of Government on Saturday for the third time since the burning of the Parliament buildings in 1849 attracted unusual attention to the deliberations of the meeting of the Cabinet in this city, outside of its important nature as a matter of internal politics.

Early on Saturday morning the residence of Sir John A. Abbott in Sherbrooke street was a focus of attraction for newspaper men. Every variety of reporter, and many who could only claim the flimsiest kind of connection with the press, were present.

With the exception of a brief interval for luncheon the cabinet sat steadily until about a quarter past four, when a very early change of the position of the Government upon the canal toll question was imparted to the world by the Premier.

The Sir John Abbott said that, in pursuance of the views of the Government as to the temporary character of the existing order—namely, the rebate on canal tolls, and of its future policy, the existing system would be terminated at the end of the present season.
