REPORT.

*The General Missionary Committee to the Friends and Supporters
of the Canadian Primitive Methodist Missions.*

CHRISTIAN FRIENDS,—Another year having passed, it becomes our duty to present the usual Report of our operations. Time flies, whether we are correspondingly working for Christ or not. The highest object of life is to work as years run their round. Work while it is called day. Fill passing time with work that will redound to God's honour, and to the good of man for ever.

As a section of the Church, we feel it incumbent upon us to take part, as far as we have means and agents, in spreading the gospel in the cities, towns, and back settlements of our country; and the Committee expresses thankfulness to Almighty God for the measure of success with which the Society has been favoured. Prosperity, we admit, has not been so great by far as we desired. Had we more means, and an additional number of suitable men, other inviting fields of labour might be entered, where there is a prospect of important results for good. At the time of writing this Report, we have before us letters containing earnest appeals for additional Agents, to be sent to destitute localities.

Among the many organizations for the good of our race, it is freely admitted that the cause of Christian Missions is of unequalled importance: the more than thousand auxiliaries that exist for the mental and moral elevation of mankind, though of vast benefit, cannot compare with the Missionary enterprise. Its success, and the results thereof, are purposes for which the Saviour died; for which the Holy Spirit pleads; and with which the Divine glory is plainly identified; and that success is guaranteed by the pen of inspiration, and by the positive assurances of God. The great field of human interests waits for agents to labour. The Master calls for labourers; and has put upon the Church the obligation and responsibility of sustaining men in the work of evangelizing the teeming millions of all races, kindreds and tongues. Hence the questions with which every Christian should ply his own heart are,—How can I do most to spread the knowledge of Christ? How can I do most for the glory of God, and for the world's conversion?

It is intensely humbling that the churches and communities of the present day are content with doing so little. Were there a higher recognition of duty, there would follow a more earnest putting forth of power and energy. The Missionary enterprise needs the ablest and most skilful men, and it well deserves them; while it requires also, and is worthy of, more abundantly liberal means than those which are presented at its altar.

There never was a time when it was more necessary that Christ should have faithful witnesses; liberal-hearted followers; and fearless, self-denying evangelists, fired with burning zeal, and willing to breast any struggle to

which they may be called, than now, that the doctrines of the Cross may be promulgated. In view of this, and of the marshaled hosts of sin for a terrible struggle, let us, as a community and as individual Christians, rise to a realization of the fact, that our Lord demands from us a vaster liberality, and a vaster faith and resolution, for the glory of His great name.

In directing your attention to our efforts, as a section of the Church, during the past year, we are thankful to say that Arthur and Rosemount Missions have prospered under the labors of the brethren appointed by the Committee to these stations. Orangeville has been made into a Circuit. Parts of Bosanquet and Macgillivray Circuits have been made into a Mission, under the name of Parkhill. We much regret that a combination of unfortunate circumstances has made it necessary for Hamilton and London Circuits to be placed under the care of the Committee, but we trust this necessity will only exist for a short time, and that both these stations will resume their old and honorable positions as Circuits.

We herewith present you our financial position. Income for the year, from the Circuits and Missions, \$7,273 32; to this sum must be added \$2,000 00, English Grant; \$114 00 from Relief Fund, towards assisting to pay the claims of sick Missionaries; and \$2,586 54 balance of last year; making a total of \$11,973 86. Our expenditure has been \$8,300 20. There is thus a balance of \$3,673 66. But this balance, and nearly *three fourths* of the present year's income, are already pledged, to pay the grants voted by the Conference. Our expenditure is yearly increasing, and it cannot be otherwise if we would be progressive; but our income for the two past years has been diminishing. The income of the present year is not so much by \$610 21 as was our income *two years ago*. We ask you to ponder this fact. There is no need for this decrease in our revenue! Can we not this year recover our position two years ago? Nay, can we not *exceed* it? Can we not raise \$8,000 00 *this year*? This will only be an increase of \$727 00 on last year's income; and "what are these 'dollars' amongst so many?" Brethren, help! "Come up to the help of the Lord, to the help of the Lord against the mighty." Many have done well in increasing their subscriptions. We earnestly trust that all who hear and read this report will also increase their offering to the Lord.

"There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and there is that withholdeth more than is meet, but it tendeth to poverty. The liberal soul shall be made fat; and he that watereth, shall be watered also himself."—Proverbs ii. 24, 25. "But this I say, he which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully."—2 Cor. ix. 6.

ARTHUR MISSION.

During the past seven months, considerable labour has been expended on this Mission, in travelling, preaching, and visiting; and we are happy to say, not in vain. The good Lord has been with us in the blessed work: much time has been spent in gaining appointments: our Mission has now six regular preaching places, and some are in a prosperous state. The members are working to spread the cause of God around them. The Mission takes in four townships, and extends some twenty miles. The township of Luther has been em-

The settlers are poor, but are willing to do what they can for the gospel.

ARMEMESIA AND SULLIVAN MISSION.

During the last ecclesiastical year on this field, your Missionary has been endeavouring to do something for the extension of the Redeemer's kingdom. During that time we have preached about 180 sermons, led class about 100 times, held special meetings for some weeks, and delivered ten addresses : to accomplish this, we have travelled about 3,000 miles. I have also attended to the visiting work, as opportunity offered. We are happy to report an increase of eight members, and trust impressions have been made on the minds of others which will lead to their conversion to God. The Mission is in a prosperous condition, and by tact and prudence, accompanied with the Lord's blessing, we are anticipating greater success. We have erected a stone church in Artemesia, which we hope may be the birth-place of many precious souls. Our finances and missionary money are in advance of last year : the Lord has been with us, and by His assistance we hope to labour on. We pray that every effort put forth by His ambassadors, in order to till the soil of fallen humanity, may be blessed to His glory, and the salvation of immortal souls.

BRANTFORD MISSION.

We have much cause for gratitude to the Giver of all good for the gracious revivals with which we have been visited since entering upon this field of labour : it has cheered the sorrowing, bound up the broken-hearted, and added a large number to our Society, enabling us, after filling up all deficiencies for the year, to report an increase of 19. This gives us the largest membership ever reported from this Mission. We preach morning and evening, superintend and teach a Bible Class in the Sabbath School, on Sabbath afternoon : the school is also increasing in numbers and interest : we have three week-night services, all of which are very well attended. For the future we trust in God, " for in the Lord Jehovah is everlasting strength."

COLLINSBY MISSION.

The financial state of the Station never was more prosperous than at present : this year we report a creditable increase in all our contributions : some of our people think they ought to be self-sustaining ; so do I. CARADOC MISSION.

In sending a brief report of our Mission, we are thankful to Almighty God we have not laboured in vain. During our special services we felt much of the Divine presence, especially at Mount Carmel : after seven weeks of incessant labour, we were enabled to add five precious souls to our ranks, and several others were powerfully affected under the word. The attendance at Longwood's appointment during the special services was good, but owing to the impassable state of the roads, we had to conclude it. During the year we have attended

fourteen missionary meetings, preached eight missionary sermons, travelled two thousand and fifty-four miles, preached nearly two hundred sermons, and visited a large number of families. Our financial and numerical report is tolerably good. We have raised as total income for the Mission \$219 85. Our Missionary income, after paying expenses, will be \$76 69, besides raising nearly \$20 for furniture and other purposes. After filling up seven removals and three fallen, we are able to report an increase of four precious souls for the year. We have also paid \$40 to the Children's Fund. We have peace and harmony within our borders, for which we feel truly thankful. That "the little one may become a thousand, and the small one a strong nation," is the sincere prayer of the writer.

COLLINGWOOD MISSION.

We have expended much labour on this Mission during the past year, and we are happy to say that we have not laboured in vain, nor spent our strength for naught. The Lord has been true to his promise, "If ye ask anything in my name, I will do it." The people asked in faith, and the Lord poured out his Spirit in copious showers, so that sinners were converted, and the church built up; and as the result of our labours and God's assisting grace, we have twenty-three of an increase for the year. We have also built one new church, which makes three Connexional Churches on the Station. We are in a prosperous state, with the exception of one or two places. A second preacher is required, in order to work the Station properly; and should we get an additional preacher, the day is not far distant when Collingwood will rise. We are in advance of last year in every department. To God be all the praise.

KINCARDINE MISSION.

The year has again passed away, making it necessary for us to give a report of our labours on this Station. We regret the year has not been as successful as we could have desired, yet we are thankful to state, that after filling up the vacancies of fallen, removals, and deaths, we are able to report a small increase of seven members. We have met all claims of Minister's salary. We have an increase in our ordinary finances of \$35, and in Missionary money about \$10; and we have added one new church to the Mission, and two others are in course of erection: one of these is a brick edifice in the village of Bervie, and is 26 by 36 feet, towards which a good subscription has been taken up: the other a frame building, to go up in the township of Ashfield, near the Goderich Road, about 16 miles from Goderich. This is a new appointment, which has done well; nearly \$30 have been raised here for the support of the gospel during the year. We have also taken up a new appointment on the North Line, Kincardine township, which we hope will do well. May the Great Head of the Church still continue to prosper the good work on this Mission, and may many be brought from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of God's dear Son.

NAPANEE MISSION.

In reviewing the labours of the past year on this Mission, your Missionary has cause to thank God and take courage. A few precious souls have been converted, and after filling up the vacancies of twenty caused by removals and fallen, we are able to report an increase. He has held three protracted meetings, travelled 3,487 miles, visited 678 families, and preached 213 sermons, besides attending to other duties. CHATHAM MISSION.

In presenting to the readers of the Missionary Report a few particulars, we may here say, that the Eternal God, through his Son Jesus Christ, has prospered our labours on this field. We have seven appointments, stretching over nearly thirty miles of country. About 275 sermons have been preached on Sabbath days; five field meetings have been held during the year; and much of the Holy Spirit has been enjoyed, both by ministers and people. Over 20 weeks have been spent in protracted meetings, and about 40 souls have joined the Church. We have to bless God for an increase of members. One new Church has been built this year; the Church and land cost over \$2,200. We have raised about \$1,000 for church purposes, and have expended \$80 in books. We have also raised \$126 63 for the Missionary work; and for the ordinary revenue of the Station we have raised \$355 35; making a total of \$1,561 98. In addition to what the members have raised, friends of our cause in this locality have given largely to the funds. Much work has been done in holding prayer-meetings, class-meetings, visiting the sick, and comforting the dying. The Sabbath Schools have increased in number and efficiency. To God be all the glory. Amen.
