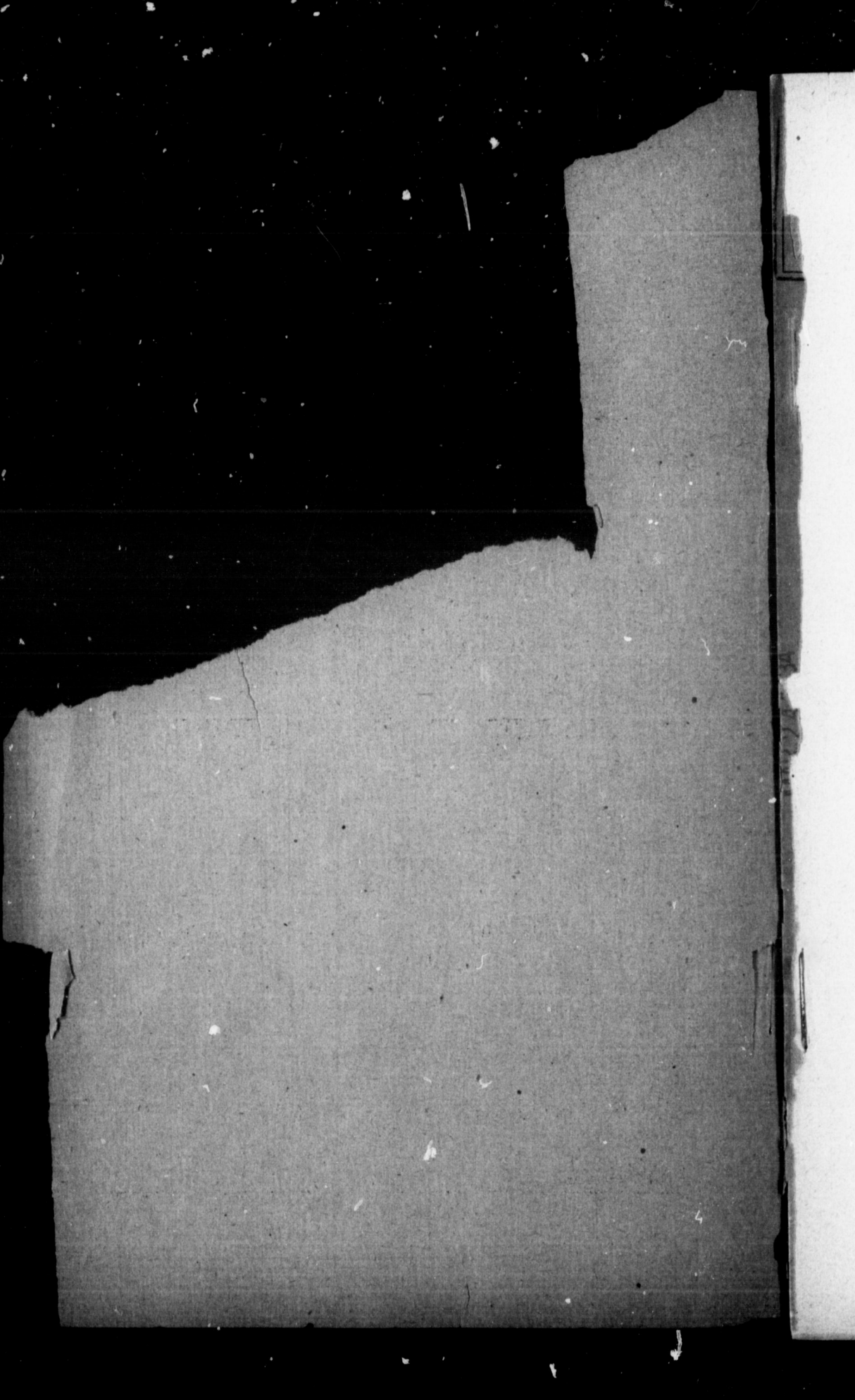

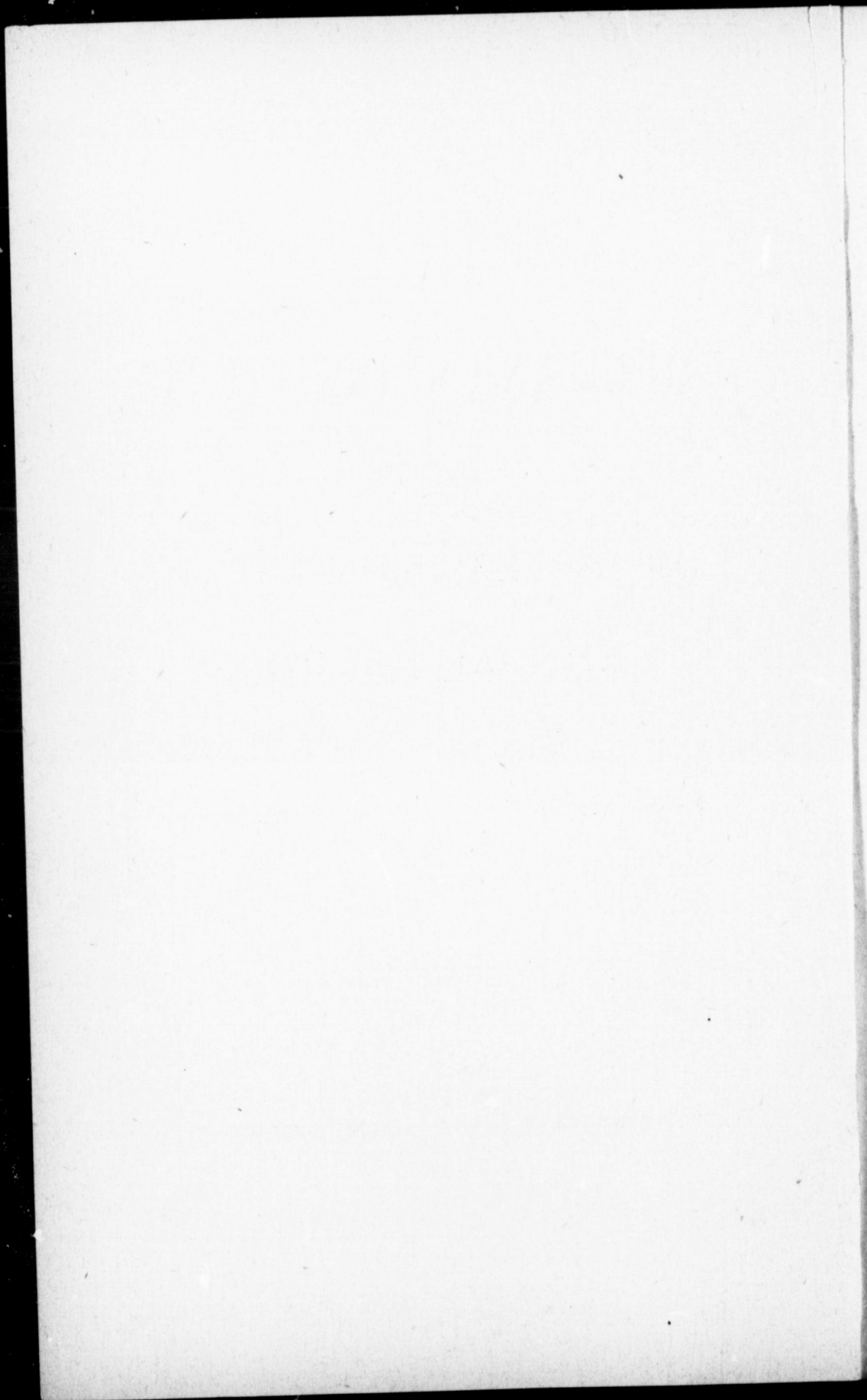

# Fifty-Sixth Annual Report.

To the Members of the *Mechanics' Institute, Montreal* :—

GENTLEMEN,

Your Committee has much pleasure in submitting the Fifty-sixth Annual Report for your consideration.

The year just closed has been an eventful one in the history of the Institute, on account of a disastrous fire which occurred on the evening of 28th January, whereby the roof of the Building was completely destroyed, and the rest of the property considerably damaged by water and smoke. The loss was covered by Insurance, but we regret to say that we lost several of our tenants whose offices have not all been re-taken.

The re-construction of the Roof, &c., was entrusted to Messrs. Brown & Macvicar, Architects, who have finished the work to the satisfaction of your Committee, and the property to-day is in good order.

## FINANCES.

The statement of the year has been printed and circulated as usual showing a balance on hand of \$1,354.43.

### LIBRARY AND READING ROOM.

The number of persons using the Library during the year was 278, and the issue of Books was 4047, being a decrease as against last year owing to the Fire. There has been added to the Catalogue 798 vols., and there was a loss of 100 caused by the water and smoke.

During the repairs to the Library and Reading Room, the Reading Room was removed at once to 255 St. James Street.

### POINT ST. CHARLES BRANCH.

The Branch is still occupied by the Salvation Army at a rental of \$200 per annum.

### OFFICES.

The number of offices rented at the close of the year was 29, and 8 vacant, being a decrease of 2 as compared with 1894.
