Address to the Lt. Governor—His Honor's Reply. At 2.30 p. m. Saturday, His Honor the Lt. Governor entered the Common Council Chamber accompanied by his A. D. C. Col. Saunders and Capt. F. Ring.

The Mayor entered attended by the Recorder, Common Clerk and Board of Aldermen. The Common Clerk read the following address:

TO HIS HONOR THE HONORABLE SAMUEL LEONARD TILLY, C. B., Lieutenant Governor of the Province of New Brunswick.

WE have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th inst., and in reply to inform you that the City of St. John embrace with pleasure the first opportunity afforded to us of tendering to Your Honor as Lieutenant Governor of the Province a hearty welcome to this City of which you have been for so long time a friend, and with which your relations, social and political, have been for many years most intimate.

We see good grounds for congratulating you on your advancement to the highest position in your native Province, a position you are so eminently qualified to fill with advantage to our varied Provincial interests, a perfect acquittal of the duties which have been acquired during a long public life.

The Mayor represented this City in the Provincial and Dominion Parliaments at a public extending over nearly a quarter of a century, and during that period he has had the honor to be elected to the administration of public affairs, in the highest office of Lieutenant Governor of the Province, and in the discharge of his duties, he has shown an earnest energy, coupled with an earnest desire to advance the prosperity of the people of this Province, and we feel assured that you will lose no opportunity of strengthening those ties which bind to the entire welfare of the Province, and which we feel it our pride to form a part, and of inculcating and cherishing those feelings of loyalty to the Sovereign, and attachment to the throne, that from our earliest history have been pre-eminent in New Brunswick.

We desire to express to Your Honor our warmest wishes for the personal welfare and happiness of yourself and Mrs. Tilly, and to assure you that such feelings are cordially entertained by all classes of the citizens we represent.

In testimony whereof the said Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of St. John have caused the Common seal of the said city to be hereunto affixed under the hand of His Honor, the Town-day of January, Anno Domini 1874.

His Honor made the following reply: To His Worship the Mayor, the Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of St. John.

GENTLEMEN: Your kind congratulatory welcome, from the civic representatives of the chief commercial city of this Province, with which I have been so long connected in its social, and public political affairs, is most gratifying, and I can find no language strong enough to convey my appreciation of your continued confidence in me, in the new and responsible position which I now occupy.

As you remark, for nearly a quarter of a century I have been the Parliamentary Representative of this City, and during all that time, in the many changes which have taken place, I have sought its prosperity; and if my services have been valuable in any degree, it is due to the aid and beneficent Sovereign who now occupies it, is not a mere sentiment, but the conviction that in the position of this connection we have the best guarantee for all our interests, and that of the Government, and I trust that no act of mine will ever weaken in any degree the ties which unite us so closely with the British Empire.

For the kindly reference to Mrs. Tilly, I thank you sincerely, and I trust that you shall ever be sustained by the good wishes and cheering words of the people of this, our native Province.

After the Mayor, Council, and city officials were presented to His Honor. A large number of citizens were also present occupying about an hour. When leaving the Council Chamber a salute was fired by a battery of artillery.
