PULVERIZING MANURE.

Suppose that a lump of manure

bring, or is best to put them in cellars? Or in the absence of cellars is it best to cover them in the field? When they are sold in fair profit, my advice is to sell in the fall; but if they cannot be sold either store them in your cellars or bury them in the field, and trust your chances to be able to sell during the winter around home, to forward them to a market early in the spring, where there is transportation by water in *Canada*. A little benefit to potato growers except in the fall as they are not so early enough in the spring. A great many potatoes can be sold in villages and large towns during the winter weather, and they must be sold before they sprout much. Potatoes were 25 cents a bushel to feed to stock raw to cows and horses, and cooked with meal for swine.

Green Food.

Green food is essential to the well-being of poultry, at all seasons of the year. When fowls are limited to confined quarters, this must be supplied to them artificially, to keep them in good health.

In winter time we can give them cabbage or chopped turnips, or

There are about 225 factories engaged in the manufacture of potato starch, and probably all of them, with one or two exceptions, are located in the States of New York, Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont. The average price paid for potatoes by starch manufacturers during the past season has been 10 cents per bushel. The aggregate net production of all the factories usually from 6,000 to 11,000 tons of bushel of potatoes generally makes 300 pounds of starch, 250 bushels, therefore, being required for a ton.
