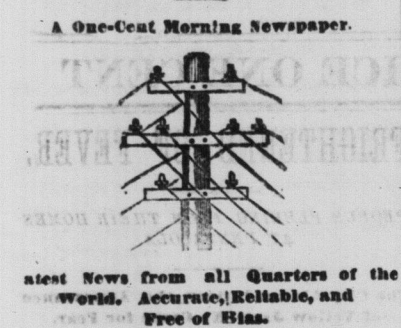

FRANCE AND CHINA
